ANNUAL REPORT-2016-2017

FORWARD:-

The Organization 'Ma Madhuri Brij Varis Sewa Sadan 'Apna Ghar'' is dedicated for achieving the mission 'to serve the living statue of god', who are homeless helpless, mentally and physically sick human beings and accidental or sick, cows and other living beings (birds and animals), generally found on roadside, railway station, bus stands, religious and other public places in very harsh and painful conditions. The Organization is putting all efforts to save the life of these human and other living beings with the blessing of almighty god. They generally found in very unhygienic situation, suffered with critical diseases, wounded, painful conditions and going towards lingering death due to lack of amenities like food, medicine and shelter. In their critical phase of life, the organization is trying its best to access them, facilities like treatment, food, shelter and other necessities of life free of cost, with the public support. These are precious human and other living beings and they should not lose their lives in absence of such basic need of life. The Organization make all efforts to save the life of these human and other living beings and give them an opportunity to live life with respect and dignity.

Apna Ghar Ashrams has played a significant role by evolving a new humanitarian concept through alliance and peoples based mechanism in order to addressing the problems of helpless, homeless and support less sick. Up to this year 17 Apna Ghar Ashrams in Bharatpur, Ajmer, Kota, Alwar, Bikaner, Jodhpur, Shriganganagar, Pali, Nokha, Hindaun and Bassi (Jaipur) Cities of Rajasthan, Puthkhurd and Budpur in Delhi, Shamli and Kokilavan (Mathura) in UP are running by the organization to serve such type of human beings. Instead of this Bharatpur Ashram is providing services for other living beings also.

This concept of the organization is unique and played a vital role to attach the community and philanthropy with the services of these most needy persons of the society. With the help of Apna Ghar Sewa Samities and Helplines members the scale and coverage of services have been expanded in other part of the country. In addition, the services of the Organisation have been expended up to Nepal last year and construction of Apna Ghar Ashram at Doleshwar Mahadeo Mandir campus, Kathmandu in under process.

Large number of peoples coming at Apnaghar from all our the county to perusal the services provided to these inmates (Prabhujis) from the Organization and they feel serenity and satisfaction after visiting here. We wish all the visitors to strengthen the humanitarian value by helping the helpless human and other living beings.

EXPANSION OF INFRASTRUCTURE AND ACCOMODATION FACILITIES During 2016-17:-

With the passage of time, the number of inmates increasing day by day in 'Apna Ghar' Ashrams, running by the organization in the country. So it becomes necessary to expend the infrastructure and accommodation facilities with expansion of 'Apna Ghar' Ashrams in other part of the state and the country, so that shelter for these homeless helpless hopeless and support less human and other beings can be made available. Within them mostly are suffering from mentally retarded, mentally sick, old aged, fractured, wounded, T.B, HIV, paralysis and other infected persons. Instead of those, accidental wounded, sick cows, birds and animals are being served at Apna Ghar Ashram Bharatpur. While expanding the accommodation and facilities, the need of every inmate is taken into consideration. The expansion of infrastructures and accommodation facilities developed during this year 2016-17 are as follows-

Apna Ghar Bansi Praklp:-

Looking for the accommodation necessity for the next 10 years of the inmates, as per the present rate of increase of inmates admitted in 'Apna Ghar', construction of new 'Apna Ghar' Ashram having accommodation capacity for 2000 inmates has been started on dated 4 November 2011 at a distance of 2 km from the present building of 'Apna Ghar' Ashram. This project is known as 'Bansi Praklap'. The Phase-I and II had already been completed during the year 2015-16 under which the following buildings had been constructed and is now fully utilized in the services of the prabhujis (Inmates).

- 1. Matra Sadan (A Residential Home for Female) having capacity 720 beds.
- 2. Ma Annpurna Prasadalay (Kitchen) having capacity of preparation of food for 2000 persons
- 3. Office & Store Building
- 4. Jeev Sewa Sadan having residential capacity for 150 Cows, birds and other animals.
- 5. Puspanjali Param Sewa Grah having capacity of 70 severe ill and wounded persons:-
- 6. Shishu evm Baal Grah (Childerns Home) having capacity 70 children
- 7. Staff Quarters for 20 employees & Garage
- 8. Water and Electric facilities
- 9. Boundary wall and internal roads in campus

 During this year the following buildings have been constructed under this praklp:-

'Apna Ghar' Matra Sadan-II:-

The foundation of Matra Sadan-II was laid on dated 23 February 2015 having construction area 70000 sq ft and proposed residential capacity for 800 inmates. During this year Matra Sadan-II was partially constructed having residential capacity for 380 inmates and inaugurated on dated ------in the auspicious presence of Sant Shri Vijay Kausal Ji Maharaj, Sh Sayad Shahnavaj Husain , National spokesperson of BJP and Sh Ramdev Singh, IG ACD Bharatpur Range. The construction area of this building is 35000 sq ft.

COW Shade:-

Cow shade was developed in Jeev Sewa Sadan during this year having residential capacity for 50 accidental or sick cows and in 8000 sq ft area. This shade was inaugurated by Sant Shri Vijay Kausal Ji Maharaj, Sh Sayad Shahnavaj Husain, National spokesperson of BJP and Sh Ramdev Singh, IG ACD Bharatpur Range. This Shade was sponsored by Sh Ravi Jain, IAS and his family members.

Expension of Children Home:-

The Foundation of expansion of Children's home was laid on dated------ by Sant Shri Vijay Kausal Ji Maharaj, Sh Sayad Shahnavaj Husain, National spokesperson of BJP and Sh Ramdev Singh, IG ACD Bharatpur Range. This home has been sponsored by Apna Ghar Sewa Samiti, Kheragarh. This expansion part is in 3200 sq ft and having accommodation facilities for 25 children. About 50 % construction work was completed during 2016-17.

HIV Block, T.B Block, Guest House, Shishu Sadan:-

The T.B Ward, HIV Ward and Guest House had been constructed up to finishing stage at the end of the year 2016-17 and will be inaugurated soon. The T.B ward has been sponsored by Apna Ghar Sewa Samiti Bari, HIV ward by Sh Somkumar Mittal, Agra and Guest House by Sh Mohanlal Agarwal, Agra

<u> Apna Ghar Helpline Bharatpur :-</u>

During 2015-16 the foundation of Apna Ghar Helpline was laid on the donated land of 10000 sq m at B-Narayangate, Bharatpur(Raj). During this year the construction of ground floor was completed and the inauguration was done on dated 10 September 2016 in the auspicious presence of Sh Shivsingh Bhont, Mayor, Nagar Nigam Bharatpur, Sh Mahanlal Agarwal renowned social worker Agra, Sh Indrajeet Singh, Deputy Mayor, Nagar Nigam Bharatpur. Following projects were started for the welfare of very poor families and individual of Bharatpur city.

1. Samaj se Samaj ki Sewa:- Under this project the surplus items of the well to do families are being deposited at the Helpline and thereafter these items are being handed over to the needy poor families.

- 2. Moksh Vahini:- The funeral places, generally are at long distant for some families, so it is the need of the day to run a harsh van in the city, so that it becomes easy to these families to take their expired near and dear ones to the funeral places. The Moksh Vahini is being served the above purpose under this project.
- 3. Medical Services:- Under this project, the medical consultancy is being provided for the most needy person in Bharatpur city by Dr R.S. Gupta, Senior Pediatrician without any charges form 5 PM to 7 PM daily.
- 4. Rehabilitation Center:- Under this project Computer training and Sewing Training are being provided at the Helpline to the most poor family girls, so that they may be self sustained. There are 30 girls in computer training and 35 girls are in sewing training at the end of the year.
- 5. Gomata Bhjan Chara Yojana:- This project was inaugurated to arrange the food for sick and hungry cows. Under this the project the collection is being done through E-Rikshaw from Bharatpur city and collected food items are served to cows at prescribed places.
- **6. A.C. Taboot** To preserve the dead body for long duration AC tabbot sewa is also running by the Helpline for Bharatpur city.

EXPENSION OF APNA GHAR ASHRAM :-

This is a new approach particularly in mobilizing the network and alliance for helping helpless, homeless and resource less sick persons. Surprisingly these groups are found everywhere but options for serving them are very limited. In crisis of supporting hands and resources, many helpless persons lost their lives and striving for resources. It was not feasible to provide services to every inmate from Bharatpur 'Apna Ghar' Ashram. To ensure services to every helpless, severe ill person, as per vision of the organization, the Expansion plan was introduce by the Organization during 2011-12. Under Expansion Plan the 'Apna Ghar' Ashram in Ajmer, Kota, Alwar, Bikaner, Jodhpur, Sh Ganganagar, Pali and Nokha in Rajasthan, Puthkhurd and Budhpur in Delhi, kokilavan (Mathura) and Shamli in UP were established by the Organization up to the financial year 2015-16. During the Year 2016-17 'Apna Ghar' Ashrams started at Hindaun and Bassi (Jaipur) in Rajasthan. Expansion of existing Ashrams to enhance the residential capacity was also continued during this year. The details of Expansion and new started ashrams is as under-

1. Expansion of Apna Ghar Ashram, Delhi Poothkhurd:-

The 'Apna Ghar' Ashram Delhi was started on dated 28 October 2012 and the residence capacity of this Ashram was 70 beds at the time of inauguration. Up to 31 March 2016 the residential capacity was extended up to 250 beds as per construction of 1st,2nd and 3rd floor. In this financial year 1050 sqm land was purchased. This land is attached to the existing Ashram and expansion from 250 beds to 650 beds is proposed after the availability of this land.

2. Expansion of Apna Ghar Ashram, Alwar:-

Apna Ghar Ashram Alwar was started on 24 June 2016 and the total residential capacity at the time of inauguration was 25 beds. During 2015-16 the residential capacity was extended to 80 beds by constructed 1st floor. During this year 1200 sqm land was purchased for 100 beds capacity women wing from UIT Alwar amounting to Rs 30 lakh.

3. Expansion of Apna Ghar Ashram, Kota:

Apna Ghar Ashram Kota was running in a part of Nari Niketan Bhawan, Nanta Kota having capacity 60 beds allotted by Rajasthan government form its inauguration. During this year the government has allotted old ruined Hostel building of Polytechnic College Kota near Airodrum Choraha having capacity 400 beds. One part of this building having capacity 100 beds was rejuvenated with cost 32 lakh and ashram was sifted from Nari Niketan Bhawan to this building during this year.

4. Expansion of Apna Ghar Ashram, Shamli:

Shamli Ashram was started on dated 29 January 2015 having residential capacity for 50 beds. During this year the residential capacity of this Ashram was extended to 150 by constructed 1st floor.

5.Expansion of Apna Ghar Ashram, Nokha:

Under the expansion plan Apna Ghar Ashram at Nokha was started on dated 5 September 2015 with capacity 30 beds which was extended up to 140 at the end of 2015-16. During this year 4 bigha land has been purchased by the Ashram on which 500 beds capacity ashram, having separate provisions for male and female inmates is proposed.

New Ashrams/ Projects During this Year

1. Apna Ghar Ashram Hindaun:-

Apna Ghar Ashram Hindaun was started on dated 31 July 2016 at Rampura Hospital building provided by Sh Yaspal Arya and their Rampura family having residential capacity for 40 beds. The inauguration of the Ashram was done in the auspicious presence of Sh Prashant Agarwal, Honorable Justice of Rajasthan High Court, MLA Smt Rajkumari Jatav and Chairman Nagar Parisad Hindaun Sh Arvind Jain.

2. Apna Ghar Ashram Bassi, Jaipur:-

Apna Ghar Ashram Bassi (Jaipur) was inaugurated on dated 18 September 2016 and the inauguration ceremony was presided over by Sh Ravi Jain, Director, Social Justice and Welfare Department, Rajasthan Government. The building for this Ashram has been provided by Sh Mahesh Parekh ji, Jaipur. The residential capacity of this building was for 30 beds, which was extended up to

80 beds by constructed 1st floor. The Laying Stone ceremony for Ist floor was done on 21 February 2016, in which the chief guest was Sh B.L. Joshi, Ex Governor of UP.

3. Apna Ghar Ashram Nepal:-

The foundation stone for 1st International Ashram of the organization was laid on dated 14 May 2016 near Doleshwar Mahadev Mandir in Bhaktpur, Kathmandu (Nepal). Sh Mahesh Basnek, Ex Industry Minister Nepal was the chief guest of the program. Sh S.K. Sarswat, Secretary, Indian high Commissioner,, Sh Tej Prasad Podel, Chief District Officer Bhaktpur, Sh Vidurman Bisnet, President Doleshwar Mahadev Samiti, Dr Jagdish Prasad, Chief Neurologist, Nepal Government were the other guest. The 1000 sq feet land for this Ashram was purchased by Apna Ghar Ashram Samiti Nepal having 25 members. The capacity of this Ashram will be for 100 beds. The construction of this ashram is in progress.

4. Apna Ghar Ashram Govardhan(Mathura) Project :-

In Govardhan (Mathura) Radhkund Prikarma Marg, near Kusum Sarovar, Narad Kund, 1.97 hectare land was donated to the organization by Sh Manish Goyal and his wife Smt Vinita Goyal with the inspiration of their Guru Swami Jugal Kishor Ji Maharaj during this year. A 800 bedding capacity Ashram is proposed on this land in which two 300-300 beds capacity residential ashrams, 100 beds capacity Sant Sadan, 50-50 beds capacity senior citizen home, 100 beds capacity Yatri Avas, Auditorium, Temple, Staff Quarters, Kitchen, Office and other facilities are proposed.

TRANSFER OF INMATES FROM OTHER ORGANIZATIONS OF INDIA:

There are certain organizations and groups in India which are working with the collaboration of the organization. The excess numbers of inmates beyond their capacity in their Homes are being transferred to Apna Ghar Ashram Bharatpur so that they may be able to help more and more such type of inmates in their area. During this year 150 such type of inmates were transferred from Manav Sewa Trust, Surat (Gujarat), 25 from Hariprabha Ashram, Shri Ganganagar, 15 from Shridha Foundation Mumbai, 25 from Jan sewa sanasthan, Rohtak (Hariyana), 18 from Ramlal Vrdhashram Agra and 50 from government homes and other ngos.

MEDICAL FACILITY:

To fulfill the medical requirements of patients of Apna Ghar Ashrams 25 part time Doctors, 40 Compounder and health worker engaged in the services during the year. The patient also provide medical treatment in Government Hospital, Medical College and private hospitals as per requirements. In all ashrams there are 25

Ambulance and 2 Animal Ambulances, engaged in the services of helpless severe ill persons to providing immediate medical services and support.

MEDICAL HELPLINE AND MOBILITY :-

Often seen that orphan and helpless patients injured in road accidents are die due to lack of medical support and care. Since the accident occurs in unpredictably manner, no attendants are available to look after these patients/injured persons in hospital, immediately. To fulfill this gap and support interruption, medical helpline support was initiated by the Organization at Bharatpur and Kota. It provides attendants in hospitals until someone from inmates families are not reported or take this responsibility. Every month the organization benefiting more than 250 such type of patients through this helpline.

REHABILITATION:

It is an important intervention of Apna Ghar's rehabilitation measures. After recovery of inmates from mental and physical sickness as per services and treatment provided by the Organization the efforts made to search their home and send them back in their families. Apart from these inmates there are number of inmates whom family do not want to accept them back. These inmates are being rehabilitated by involving them in the services of the Organization. The steps involved in entire rehabilitation process include:

- (i) Information to family members through letters and telephones as soon as the inmate are able to inform of the same.
- (ii) Information to local police station and requested them to do needful steps.
- (iii) In case of unidentified address or non-cooperation situation, local police are consulted to locate the exact addresses.
- (iv) In case of non-cooperation by family legal action are supposed to be taken.

If all above efforts are failed, the members/representatives from organization visit to the concerning area along with person and ensure all possibilities of proper rehabilitation.

As on 31 March 2016 there were 2602 Prabhuji (Inmates) residing in all Apna Ghar Ashrams. During this year 2656 Prabhuji (inmates) admitted and 1288 Prabhuji (Inmates) rehabilitated by all Ashrams. Due to poor health, incurable diseases and old age 628 persons were expired. The strength of inmates in all Apna Ghar Ashrams running by the Organization, as on 31st March 2017 was 3342.

EXPANSION OF ASHRAM SAMITIES, APNAGHAR SEVA SAMITIES AND HELPLINES:-

Organization has limited man power and resources to serve large number of helpless, homeless and resource less sick persons. Within this limited resources reaching to every patient is almost impossible for organization alone. For reaching at large number of such person, organization has promoted Apna Ghar seva samities (local units) and helpline at District and Tehsil level. 35 Apna Ghar seva samities and 48 help lines support the mission and objectives of organization in different part of state and the country at present.

TURNING TOWARDS HUMANITARIAN PILGRIM:-

The genesis of concept to serve helpless, orphan was inspired spirits and for fulfilling it very limited activities were initiated. This pretty small initiation of service through Apna Ghar magnificently is turning towards humanitarian hubs. Many of individuals after visiting Apna Ghar and staying couple of days they inspiring with its way of serving and humanity. Large number of people from villages and cities coming to visit Apna Ghar as pilgrims. Now the people visiting here expressed as mental peace and stress therapy.

NATION WIDE VOLUNTEERISM:-

In modern age where high majority of population is fascinating to materialistic attributes the increasing numbers of volunteerism for caring humanity and helpless is consisting a big turning of re-synthesis of humanism. And making this in reality Apna Ghar through action based strategy is fortunate enough as numbers of supporters and volunteers have joined. More than 200000 persons have visited and involved themselves in serving the inmates as per their skills and talents directly of indirectly.

BIRTH DAY CELEBRATION :-

Since the inmates are mentally harassed they need attention in caring. Organization in order to give them homely environment to the children and inmates the celebration of birth day is really giving them a joy and sense of special member in the family of Apna Ghar. In this celebration process all the inmates along with staffs take part in this moment. All together they wish for happy and prosper life to children. Birth celebration inculcates family spirit and enabling environment that they ever had got it.

Blood Donation Camps :-

To fulfill the requirement of blood in the Government hospitals for the needy patients the Blood donation camps were organized during this year by the Apna Ghar Samities and Apna Ghar Ashrams on the eve of Foundation Day of the Organization and other important days. A total of 350 units of blood was donated by the members of the Samities and Ashrams of the Organization during this year.
