ANNUAL REPORT-2022-2023

FORWARD: -

The Organization 'Ma Madhuri Brij Varis Sewa Sadan 'Apna Ghar" is dedicated for achieving the mission 'to serve the living statue of god', who are homeless helpless, mentally and physically sick human beings and accidental or sick, cows and other living beings (birds and animals), generally found on roadside, railway station, bus stands, religious and other public places in very harsh and painful conditions. The Organization is putting all efforts to save the life of these human and other living beings with the blessing of almighty god. They generally found in very unhygienic conditions, suffering with critical diseases, wounded, painful conditions and going towards lingering death due to lack of amenities like food, medicine and shelter. In their critical phase of life, the organization is trying its best to rescue them, provide them treatment, food, shelter and other necessities of life without any charges and with the public support. These are precious human and other living beings and so should not be lost their lives due to lack of the basic need of life. The Organization make all efforts to save the life of these human and other living beings and give them an opportunity to live their life with respect and dignity.

Apna Ghar Ashrams has played a significant role by evolving a new humanitarian concept through alliance and people-based mechanism in order to eradicate the sufferings of homeless helpless and hopeless sick living beings. At the end of this year 53 Apna Ghar Ashrams were running in 10 states of India by the Organization out of which 22 in Rajasthan (Bharatpur, Ajmer, Kota, Alwar male & female, Bikaner, Jodhpur, Shri Ganganagar, Kotda Ajmer, Vridhhashram Bikaner, Pali, Nokha, Hindaun, Bassi (Jaipur), Jaipur, Jamdoli (Jaipur), Udaipur, Kuchaman City, Pushkar,

Bari (Dholpur), Vijaynagar (Ajmer), and Neem Ka Thana (Sikar)), 3 in Delhi (Puthkhurd, Budpur and Punjabkhore), 14 in Uttar Pradesh (Shamli, Kokilavan (Mathura), Govardhan, Hathras, Firozabad, Shukratal, Varanasi, Meerut, Aminagar Sarai (Bagpat), Lucknow, Vrindavan, Pilkhua, Noida & Kanpur), 4 in M.P. (Shivpuri Male & Female, Dabra, Bhopal), 3 in Gujrat (Umta (Mehasana), Vadodara and Gandhidham), 2 in Maharashtra (Pune Male & Female), 2 in Chhattisgarh (Raigarh and Raipur), one each in West Bangel (Purulia), Haryana (Bhiwani) and Orissa. Apart from that one Ashram is running in Bhaktpur Kathmandu in Nepal i.e. outside India. In all 54 Ashrams running by the Organization there are 10385 homeless helpless destitute persons are being served as on 31st March 2023. In addition to helpless human beings Bharatpur Ashram is also providing services for helpless sick wounded cows, animals and birds. Apart from that a helpline with name Apna Ghar Helpline Bharatpur and Pradhanmantri Jan Aushadhi Kendra Agra are also being operated by the Organization.

This concept of the organization is unique and played a vital role to attach the community and philanthropy with the services of these most needy persons of the society. With the help of Apna Ghar Sewa Samities and Helpline members, the scale and coverage of services have been expanded in other part of the country and in Nepal.

Large number of peoples are coming at Apna Ghar Ashrams from all over the country to perusal the services provided to these Prabhuji (Inmates) by the Organization and they feel serenity and satisfaction after visiting here. We wish all the visitors for strengthening the humanitarian value by helping such hopeless helpless human and other living beings.



EXPANSION OF ACCOMODATION FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE During 2022-23:-

With the passage of time, the number of Prabhuji (inmates) are increasing day by day in 'Apna Ghar' Ashrams. So, it becomes necessary to expend the infrastructure and accommodation facilities by expanding 'Apna Ghar' Ashrams in other part of the Rajasthan state and the country so that shelter for these homeless helpless hopeless and support less human and other beings can be made available. Most of them are mentally retarded or suffering from mentally sick, old aged, fractured, wounded, T.B, HIV, paralysis and other infectious diseases. In addition, the accidental wounded sick cows, birds and animals are also being served at Apna Ghar Ashram Bharatpur. While expanding the accommodation and other facilities, the need of each inmate is also taken into consideration. The expansion of accommodation facilities and infrastructures developed during the year 2022-23 are as follows-

Apna Ghar Banshi Praklap Bharatpur:

Looking for the accommodation necessity, the construction of new 'Apna Ghar' Ashram having accommodation capacity for 2000 inmates had been started on dated 4th of November 2011 at a distance of 2 km from the present building of 'Apna Ghar' Ashram. This project is known as 'Bansi Praklap'. The project has been completed during this year and fully utilized for the services of Prabhujis(Inmates). Following buildings/part of the project was completed up to the financial year 2020-21.

- 1. Matra Sadan-I (A Residential Home for Female) having capacity 720 beds.
- 2. Matra Sadan-II (A Residential Home for Female) having capacity 800 beds.
- 3. HIV Block- Having residential capacity for 70 HIV Patients.
- 4. T.B. Block- Having residential capacity for 70 TB Patients.
- 5. Puspanjali Param Sewa Grah having capacity of 70 severe ill and wounded persons
- 6. Shishu evm Baal Grah (Childerns Home) having capacity 100 children
- Jeev Sewa Sadan having residential capacity for 150 Cows, birds and other animals.
- 8. Ma Annpurna Prasadalay (Kitchen) having capacity of preparation of food for 2000 persons
- 9. Guest House- For 35 Guests/ Volunteers
- 10. Office & Store Building
- 11. Jeev Sewa Sadan having residential capacity for 150 Cows, birds and other animals.
- 12. Staff Quarters for 20 employees & Garage
- 13. Water and Electric facilities
- 14. Boundary wall and internal roads in campus
- 15. Apna Ghar Lilavai Hospital
- 16. Sh Shankar Somani Prasadalay
- 17. Purush Sadan-I having residential capacity of 500 beds
- 18. Purush Sadan-II having residential capacity of 300 beds
- 19. Apna Ghar Upper Primary School

Now Apna Ghar Banshi Praklap Bharatpur has been completed and being used for the service of homeless helpless prabhuji.

Apna Ghar Prabhu Prakalp Bharatpur:

Under Apna Ghar Prabhu Praklap the construction of 8000 bed capacity home for the homeless helpless destitute females is under progress. This project was started on 01st October 2020 and its proposed completion date is 30th September 2027. The Phase-I of this project having residential capacity of 1700 beds has been completed and the inauguration

was held on 01st January 2023 with the auspicious presence of Swami Parmanand Ji Maharaj, Rohtak, Sh S.P.Singh Ji Baghel, Honourable Minister of State Law and Justice, Government of India, Dr Subhash Garg, Honourable Minister of State of Technical Education Minister & Ayurveda Rajasthan Government, Sh Nand Todi ji & Smt Shashi ji Todi, USA, Sh Sanwarmal Verma, Divisional Commissioner Bharatpur, Sh Ravi Jain, Commissioner JDA, Sh Alok Ranjan, Collector Bharatpur, Sh Ramesh Ji Agrawal, MD Agrawal packers and movers, Sh B.M. Kakar ji Delhi, respected members of Ashrams, Samities and helplines run by the organization in different part of India and other dignitaries and citizens.

Following buildings were constructed and dedicated to the homeless helpless prabhuji residing at Apna Ghar Ashram Bharatpur during this year under the first phase-I of the Prabhu Praklap.

1. **CAMPUS-2**:

A-Ground Floor: 2 Nos. Children Homes (Age 0 to 1.5 & 1.5 to 4,) having capacity 45 & 35 beds, 4 Nos. Mother's Homes having capacity 50, 50, 55 & 55 bed.

B-First Floor: 2 Nos. Children Homes (Age 4 to 10 & 10 to 18) having capacity 30 & 20 beds, 4 Nos. Mentally Retarded Homes having capacity 50, 50, 55& 55 bed.

C-Second Floor: Library for children

2. CAMPUS-3:

A-Ground Floor: Cardiac Home (capacity 70 bed), Diabetic Home (Capacity 70 bed), 2 Nos Hospice Homes having capacity 32 bed each, Pain Home (Capacity 80 bed), Respiratory Home (capacity 75 bed) & Physically Disable Home (capacity 45 bed).

B-First Floor: 2 Nos. Mentally Retarded Home (Capacity 45 bed each), 4 Nos Specific Home (Capacity 75, 75, 80 & 80 bed), Volunteers Home (Capacity 45 bed).

C-Second Floor: Tailoring Training Centre (for 50 Prabhuji at a time) Area 3200 sqft & store.

3. CENTRALIZED KITCHEN:

This kitchen is one of the largest Kitchen in India having capacity to prepare food for 11000 Prabhuji. There will be separate parts in it to prepare food as per need of the Prabhuji. Latest machinery and equipment have been fixed in this Kitchen. It has a centralized store in its basement and sewasathi quarters on non-fire zone of first floor. One specific kitchen, to prepare food as per need of individual prabhuji has also been developed in this kitchen..

4. CAFETERIA:

To fulfil the desire and need of individual prabhuji this Cafeteria

have been planned and developed to prepare all such food like south Indian dishes, fast food, sweets, dry fruits, namkeens, bakery items etc. so as to satisfy all Prabhujis.

This facilities of providing special food items will be available twice a month to a single prabhuji. It will have luxury at a picnic



by eating their favourite food items in the new outing atmosphere.

5. THEATRE:

Apna Ghar Prabhu Prakalp is not just a shelter home but will facilitate all

such activities available to a common citizen to enjoy the life. So, considering the overall need of the prabhujis may be physically or emotionally this Theatre concept have been developed in this project so that prabhujis can enjoy the lives and simultaneously entertain themselves by



watching meaningful cinema as per their desire and wish.

6. SHOPPING CENTRE:

A Shopping Centre have also been developed in this project to fulfil the

personal needs of the Prabhujis. At this Sopping centre, the Prabhuji can purchase different personal items as per their desire and wish. Though the organization is providing all these items at present yet when prabhuji will get these items as per their choice then they definitely will have a different feeling of satisfaction, happiness



and contentment on their faces and in their consciousness.

7. TRAINING CENTRE:

The services of the Organization are expanding all over the country. There are more than 50 Apna Ghar Ashrams are running in 12 States of India and the expansion of Bharatpur Ashram is also being done. For this, the staff for the exclusive services being provided by the organization requires a regular base training. The Organization has prepared need-based service manuals to guide our staff. These manuals fulfil the all requirements of the organization. To trained our staff effectively, a training centre having sitting capacity of 150 has been developed. In this training centre, the training can be provided to the 50 types of the staff of the organization with refresher course to the existing staff.

8. MEETING HALL:

At headquarter, different types of meetings for the General Body, Executive, Ashrams, Coordinators, Samities, Staff, Supporters and Visitors being organized on regular basis. For this, a meeting hall having sitting arrangements for 300 participants has been constructed in phase first.

9. DINING HALL:

For dining facilities of the visitors, staff, members, programs & volunteer Prabhuji etc. a 500-dining capacity at a time has been constructed.

10. ABHISHEK BHAWAN:

Prabhuji will be admitted first in the Abhishek Bhawan where their cleaning, bathing, dressing, counselling and all immediate required services etc. with all required investigations and diagnosis will be done. Thereafter they will shift to their allotted ward as per their disease and service need.

11. OFFICE:

Office plays a very important role for the effective working of any institution. This Office of the Organization will work on two levels, one for Ashrams and other for the head office. There are different sections for different duties of the staff in the office.

13. DEVELOPMENT OF OTHER SERVICES:

14. SPIRITUAL PARK:

Looking to the need of worship of the prabhuji this Spiritual centre has been developed. In this centre, the worship place for Hindu, Sikh, Muslims, Christian, Jain, Bodhh etc. has been developed. This is an octagon shaped

building having its diameter 100 feet. About 1000 prabhuji at a time can worship in this centre.

Goshala Expansion:

The Organization is also running a very big Goshala which was handed over by the Nagar Nigam Bharatpur last on $5^{\rm th}$ May 2022 because they were

not able to run it. This Goshala is just 2 Km away from the Ashram and at the time of hand over there were 900 cows and cattle in the Goshala and the death rate of cows was more than 20 per day. In spite their full efforts, Nagar Nigam was not able to control the mismanagement and death rate of cows in this Goshala. There was no proper infrastructure like cow shade, Generator,



tractor, loader etc. in the Goshala and the cows were forced to remain in open area at the peak time of summer. Also, the arrangement of fodder and water for the cow was not sufficient and proper

After taking the charge of the Goshala, the infrastructure as per need

of the cows was developed by the organization. The proper arrangements of fodder and water facilities was made so that the cow should not remain without fodder and water. Under the arrangements, 4 new shades for the cows having capacity for 250 cows each, one fodder depot, staff quarters, Go-**Abhshek** Ghat (Bathing



arrangements for cows with fountains system) were established, Generators, 3 tractors, 2 trollies, 2 water tankers, one loader and other essential machinery and equipment were purchased to provide the better services to these cows and cattle.

As per effective monitoring and proper arrangements of chara-dana (fodder & grain etc.) now the death rate has decreased to 4 per day against the 20 per day initially. Also, now there are more than 1700 cows and cattle in this Goshala. These cows are generally wandering on roads in helpless sick wounded conditions and admitted to the Goshala from these places. So, many of them admitted in very critical condition and could not be recovered in spite of treatment and care.

EXPENSION OF APNA GHAR ASHRAM :-

This is a new approach particularly in mobilizing the network and alliance for helping helpless, homeless and sick persons having no resources. Surprisingly these groups are found everywhere but options for serving them are very limited. In crisis of resources, many helpless persons lost their lives due to lack of resources, help and care. It was not feasible to provide services to every inmate from Bharatpur 'Apna Ghar' Ashram. Therefore, to ensure services to every helpless, severe ill person, as per vision of the organization, the Expansion of the services was started by the Organization during 2011-12. Under Expansion Plan 48 'Apna Ghar' Ashram were running at the end of last financial year 2021-22, in 10 States of India, out of which 20 were in Rajasthan (Bharatpur, Ajmer, Kota, Alwar, Bikaner, Jodhpur, Shriganganagar, Pali, Nokha, Hindaun, Bassi (Jaipur), Jaipur, Alwar (Female), Jamdoli (Jaipur), Pushkar and Bari), 2 in Delhi (Puthkhurd and Budpur), 11 in U.P. (Shamli, Kokilavan (Mathura), Govardhan, Hathras, Firozabad, Shukratal, Varanasi, Meerut, Vrindavan, Lucknow and Pilkhua), 4 in M.P. (Shivpuri, Sirsuad, Dabra and Bhopal), 2 in W. Bengal (Purulia and Kolkata), 2 in Gujrat (Umta (Mehasana), Gandhidham), one each in Haryana (Bhiwani), Orissa (Cuttak), Chhattisgarh (Raigarh) and Maharashtra (Pune). Apart from that one Ashram was running in Bhaktpur Kathmandu in Nepal. During this year 7 new 'Apna Ghar' Ashrams have been started the details of which are as follows-

1.) Apna Ghar Ashram Pune Male (Maharashtra)

This Ashram was started for the male prabhuji on 15th of May 2022. The 100 beds capacity building was constructed by the Pune Apna Ghar Ashram team Sh Arvind Jain, Sh Rahul Rathi, Sh Rajiv Agarwal, Smt Minakshi Agarwal and Sh Rakesh Soni for this Ashram.

2.) Apna Ghar Mahila Ashrma Shivpuri (M.P.)

Apna Ghar Mahila Ashram, Shivpuri was started on **07** August **2022.** This Ashram is being run by Shri Kailash Narayan Dube, Smt Babita Jain Patte Wale & all Womens Executive body. The Ashram is a branch of Apna Ghar Ashram, Shivpuri. The **25** beds capacity building has been provided on rent by Nagar Palika. All required facilities such as treatment, food, clothing, residence and other necessities are being provided to the Prabhuji (inmates) without any charges. This Ashram is especially for female Prabhuji and the Prabhuji beyond capacity transfer to Bharatpur Ashram from here.

3.) Apna Ghar Ashram Noida (U.P.)

Apna Ghar Ashram Noida (Uttar Pradesh) was started on **01 May 2022**. The 200 beds capacity building for this Ashram has been provided by the government of Uttar Pradesh . There are more than 200 Prabhuji residing in this ashram at present. All required facilities such as treatment, food, clothing, residence and other necessities are being provided to the Prabhuji (inmates) without any charges. This Ashram is especially for female Prabhuji and the Prabhuji beyond capacity transfer to Bharatpur Ashram from here.

4.) Apna Ghar Ashram Kanpur (U.P.)

The 30 beds capacity building for this Ashram was provided by Sh Harish Barti, USA. The Ashram was started in this building on 10th October 2022. This Ashram will rescue the Prabhuji found in Kanpur and nearby and excess Prabhuji beyond the capacity are transferring to Bharatpur Ashram.

5.) Apna Ghar Ashram Neem Ka Thana, Sikar (Rajasthan):

This Ashram was inaugurated as on 20 December 2022 in the auspicious presence of Dr Jitendra Singh, MLA Khetdi, Dr B.M. Bhardwaj, founder of Apna Ghar Org, Sh Veer Pal Singh, Patron, Dr Rajendra Modi & Smt Neelam Modi USA other dignitaries and respected members of the Ashram and citizens of Neem Ka Thana. The capacity of this Ashram is of 200 prabhuji and it has been built by Kapil Modi Foundation, Neem Ka Thana on 3 bigha land.

6.) Apna Ghar Ashram Punjabkhore (Delhi):

This Ashram was started for the male prabhuji on 29th January 2023 in the auspicious presence of Sh Ramnivas Goyal, honourable president Delhi Assembly, other dignities and members. The residential capacity of this Ashram is 675 beds and it has been built by the Sh Lord Krishna Foundation Delhi. This Ashram will also be operated by the Lord Krishna Foundation under the guidance of the Apna Ghar Organization. This is the third Ashram in Delhi for the service of helpless destitute sick prabhuji.

7.) Apna Ghar Ashram Raipur (Chhattisgarh):

This Ashram was started on 30th March 2023, by admitting the prabhuji in the Ashram. The capacity of this Ashram is of 210 beds which include 130 bedding capacity for male and 80 for female. The building for this Ashram has been constructed and dedicated to the service of helpless destitute sick prabhuji by Sh Gopal Agarwal and Smt Shakuntla Agrawal, the founder of M/S Shakuntala Gopal Foundation and MD Vandna Group.

Proposed New Ashrams:

There are 6 Ashrams proposed to be started near future. The details of which are as under-

Expansion of Existing Apna Ghar Ashrams:

1.) Shri Ganganagar (Rajasthan):

The construction of 500 bedding capacity building for this Ashram is under progress and scheduled to be completed within next 2 years. The 15 bedded hospital building (Janta Clinic) and 180 bedded residential building for prabhuji has already been completed. The construction work remaining part on ground and first floor is under progress.

2.) Vridhhashram Jamdoli, Jaipur (Rajasthan):

This Ashram initially was started in the Vridhhashram building given by the Government of Rajasthan in Jamdoli, Jaipur for 25 old aged females which was extended to 200 old aged females by the Rajasthan Government by providing buildings. Now the construction of the 200 bed building is under progress at Jamdoli Ashram on the land provided by Rajasthan Government.

3.) Shivpuri (M.P.):

The construction of 600 beds capacity building is under progress and first phase of this Ashram having capacity 120 beds has been completed.

4.) Bassi, Jaipur (Rajasthan):

The capacity of this Ashram is of 185 bed. Now the construction of 25 bed capacity building is under progress.

5.) Shukratal (Uttar Pradesh):

Construction work for 200 bedding capacity building has been completed and the construction of Guashala & Old Age Home is under planning.

6.) Umta, Mehasana (Gujrat)

Construction of 200 bed capacity building is under progress. There is a provision for both male and female residential homes have been taken in this building.

7.) Cuttack (Orissa)

Construction of 150 bed capacity building is under progress on the first floor of the Ashram.

8.) Kota (Rajasthan)

Renovation work of the remaining part of the Ashram is under progress.

9.) Bari, Dhaulpur (Rajasthan)

Construction of 350 bed capacity Ashram on the ground floor is in progress on the 80000 sqft land donated by Sh Keshav Chand Mangal USA.

10.) Govardhan (U.P.)

Construction of 100 bed capacity building is under progress.

<u>Detail of Prabhuji Rescued/ Admitted, Rehabilitated and Expired</u> <u>during 2022-23:-</u>

As on 31 March 2022 there were **8226** Prabhuji (Inmates) residing in all Apna Ghar Ashrams. During this year **7250** Prabhuji (inmates) rescued and admitted and **3866** Prabhuji (Inmates) rehabilitated by all Ashrams. Due to poor health, incurable diseases and old age 1225 persons were expired. The number of prabhuji (Inmates) in all 55 Apna Ghar Ashrams, as on 31st March 2023 were **10385**.

<u>Use of modern and latest Technology for improving the quality of services and system:</u>

Our monitoring system at various level makes our services effective which includes-

1. Annual Service Calendar- In this calendar, all activities related to services of the prabhujis, related to meetings of General Body/ Executive of Organization, Ashrams, Samities and helplines, Staff and office bearers trainings and workshops, other office related activities have been classified date wise. Every day as per work/ activities mentioned in the

calendar informed to the concern and monitored its compliance through WhatsApp groups. There are 450 activities has been mentioned in the calendar for 365 days of the year.

- **2. Daily Service Report-** of Prabhujis regarding number of prabhujis who have not had food, medicine with reasons, how many prabhuji have not taken their bath, not get their nails cut, how many bedsheets not changed on beds with prescribed reasons, report on toilets and ward inspection, chlorination of water during the day have to be submit by the ward incharge in office everyday by 2 PM. Other monitoring reports related to Wards, Office, Store, Kitchen, Medical and General Section etc. get from the related sections with checklists, so that quality of the services may be ensured.
- 3. Accounts, Prabhuji's Data- (admission form with details of prabhuji i.e. Name, age, health status, location from where they have been admitted, name of the informer, driver name and vehicle used for rescue with no., the cash or valuable material found from the prabhuji maintained, data related to their ward, progress of their health, address informed by the prabhuji etc. are also maintained online, by this the report of prabhuji state wise, district wise, disease wise, age wise, gender wise can be downloaded), Store, Staff, Medical and other records are being maintained on the Software developed by the Organization for the same. Face recognition system of the prabhuji has also been developed in the software. By this, the prabhuji can easily be traceable and individual services can be provided to the easily.
- <u>4. E-Clinic</u> Super specialist medical services are getting through E- Clinic from doctors anywhere in the world. Treatment of prabhujis through E-clinic by Doctors from U.S.A, England, in India doctors from Bangalore and Amritsar right now. Presently consulting by doctors through E- Clinic for 16 days in a month are being given for more than 400 prabhujis of Ashram free of charges.
- **5.** Training and workshop for staff and office bearers- The Organization has its own need based service and duty manual. Training and workshop provide to all type of staff to develop the skill and to update the office bearers by the theme/ services of the Organization.
- <u>6. Daily planning and timely meetings</u>- To take immediate and proper decisions and planning on day basis, meetings of core committee

(constituted with main office bearers), Executive board takes place on regular basis.

7. Care every individual prabhujis- The system is so developed, so that care individual prabhuji can be ensured. everv 8. Effective implementation through coordinators, section in charges that is operated by executive member of the Organization. 9. Transparency and faith- Maximum service part of each section (Medical, Accounts, Literature, Jeev Sewa, Social Media, Establishment, Store, Record Keeping, Prabhuji individual file record, Kitchen etc) is being either executed or monitored through the volunteers of the Organization. Hence all works in the Ashrams are being executed by the volunteers and staff with faith and transparent manner. And any person can get involve or take information of any type and any time from the Ashrams. 10. Strictly implementation of polices of the Organization at every level.

MEDICAL FACILITY:-

To fulfill the medical requirements of patients of Apna Ghar Ashrams more than 50 part time Doctors, 92 trained nursing staff and health worker engaged in the services during the year. The patient also provide medical treatment in Government Hospital, Medical College and private hospitals as per requirements. In all ashrams there are 71 Ambulances and 2 Animal Ambulances, engaged in the services of helpless severe ill persons to providing immediate medical services and support.

MEDICAL HELPLINE AND MOBILITY:-

Often seen that orphan and helpless patients injured in road accidents are die due to lack of medical support and care. Since the accident occurs in unpredictably manner, no attendants are available to look after these patients/injured persons in hospital, immediately. To fulfil this gap and support interruption, medical helpline support was initiated by the Organization at Bharatpur and Kota. It provides attendants in hospitals until someone from inmates families are not reported or take this responsibility. Every month the organization benefiting more than 250 such type of patients through this helpline.

Apart from the expansion of the services, the Organization is focusing on monitoring and maintaining the quality of services being providing by the Organisation. The details of which are as under-

Sewa Updation Team:

During this year we have initiated a new concept for monitoring, implementation and maintaining the services of all the Ashrams by introducing a team of staff having experts of office, medical, direct services, cleaning & multi-purpose worker. This team is monitoring, implementing and updating the services of every Ashram as per norms of the Organization and submit its report to the head quarter for further follow-up.

Expansion of Samities And Helplines:

Organization has limited man power and resources to serve large number of helpless, homeless and resource fewer sick persons. Within these limited resources reaching to every patient is almost impossible for organization alone. For reaching at large number of such person, organization has promoted Apna Ghar seva samities (local units) and helpline at District and Tehsil level. 41 Apna Ghar seva samities and 58 help lines support the mission and objectives of organization in different part of state and the country at present.

Turning Towards Humanitarian Pilgrim:

The genesis of concept to serve helpless, orphan was inspired spirits and for fulfilling it very limited activities were initiated. This pretty small initiation of service through Apna Ghar magnificently is turning towards humanitarian hubs. Many of individuals after visiting Apna Ghar and staying couple of days here, inspires with its way of serving and humanity. Large number of people from villages and cities coming to visit Apna Ghar as pilgrimage.

Nation Wide Volunteerism:

In modern age where high majority of population is fascinating to materialistic attributes the increasing numbers of volunteerism for caring humanity and helpless is consisting a big turning of re-synthesis of humanism. And making this in reality Apna Ghar through action based strategy is fortunate enough as numbers of supporters and volunteers have joined. More than 1000000 persons have visited and involved themselves in serving the inmates as per their skills and talents directly or indirectly.

Uniqueness of the Organization:

- 1. The Organization is working for the last needy person i.e., homeless helpless orphans going towards lingering death.
- 2. Every such person admit in the Ashram whether the accommodation is available or not. Because the needy outside the Ashram has the first right on the resources of the Ashrams.
- 3. The services are being executed with direct involvement of the society. So many volunteers are getting involved in the services for these helpless destitute prabhuji in the Ashrams.
- 4. The services provided in the Ashrams are as per the need of the inmates living in the Ashram not as per the resources available.
- 5. No donation is collected from the society directly but a letter to God is placed at the bord at every Ashram of the Organization and the demand written on the display bord always fulfilled by God through various human beings comes at the Ashram.
- 6. The Organization has its own system to pick up the helpless orphan destitute person from the spot. Ambulances and rescue team at the Ashrams always ready to attend every call received through any means.
- 7. To reach every such needy, Samities and Helplines constituted by the Organization at local level are also available in many cities, so that service to that needy can be provided without any delay. These Samities and Helplines are working as referral centres for the needy persons found in their areas.

Organizational Achievements:


- 1. The main achievement of the Organization is that we are following our vision and mission with our ethics and determination.
- 2. There are 56 Ashrams having residential capacity for more than 12000 beds are being running and we are in a position to cover up almost major part of Northern India to provide services to these homeless helpless hopeless persons.


- 3. Apna Ghar Ashram Bharatpur is now become the largest institute of India of its kind, as per number of prabhujis, specifications and services.
- 4. We have rehabilitated more than 25000 such type of prabhujis in their familis or other way after been cured, in 23 states of India. During admission prabhujis generally are not in a condition to inform about their addresses, even about their name and number of cases, the name has been given by the Organization. As per regular treatment and care maximum prabhuji are in the position to inform some details about their families. The family addresses informed by the prabhujis are then search by the Rehabilitation Cell of the Organization through internet, police and other means. After searching and confirmation about the family, the information of their family member residing in the Ashram is given and through proper verification and legal formalities the prabhuji handed over to their family. In many cases the family not agree try to take them back, such prabhuji get involved in different service activities like kitchen, sewing, office, medical, construction, gate keeper, Assistance in different sections etc. Some prabhuji are never able to inform about themselves, will be remained in the Ashram and get involved in the services.


It is our fundamental duty to provide health, moral values, education and family as per possibility to the children of the Organization. So, the children are admitted in the best schools, so that they can get qualitative education and get employment easily when they be adult. The girls who are in marriage age, marriage for those girls arranged by the Organization in well settled families.

- 5. More than 10 lakh peoples (members, volunteers, donners, helpmates, silent supporters, followers on social media etc.) are attached with the services of the Organization directly or indirectly.
- 6. The Organization is continually maintaining the quality of services (as mentioned above) with the expansion of Ashrams and continually increasing the number of Prabhuji.
- 7. Through these services we have developed the faith of the people up to that level that lakhs of people come every year in the Ashrams acknowledging it as a worship place according to their own faith through so many buses and other vehicles with banner of "Pilgrimage of Apna Ghar".
















Distribution of staff according to salary levels as on 31/03/2022
