ANNUAL REPORT-2024-2025

FORWARD: -

The Organization 'Ma Madhuri Brij Varis Sewa Sadan 'Apna Ghar'' is dedicated for achieving the mission 'to serve the living statue of god', who are homeless helpless, mentally and physically sick human beings and accidental or sick, cows and other living beings (birds and animals), generally found on roadside, railway station, bus stands, religious and other public places in very harsh and painful conditions. The Organization is putting all efforts to save the life of these human and other living beings with the blessing of almighty god. They generally found in very unhygienic conditions, suffering with critical diseases, wounded, painful conditions and going towards lingering death due to lack of amenities like food, medicine and shelter. In their critical phase of life, the organization is trying its best to rescue them, provide them treatment, food, shelter and other necessities of life without any charges and with the public support. These are precious human and other living beings and so should not be lost their lives due to lack of the basic need of life. The Organization make all efforts to save the life of these human and other living beings and give them an opportunity to live their life with respect and dignity.

Apna Ghar Ashrams has played a significant role by evolving a new humanitarian concept through alliance and people-based mechanism in order to eradicate the sufferings of homeless helpless and hopeless sick living beings. At the end of this year 61 Apna Ghar Ashrams were running in 12 states of India by the Organization out of which **24 in Rajasthan** (Bharatpur, Ajmer, Kota, Alwar male & female, Bikaner, Jodhpur, Shri Ganganagar, Kotda Ajmer, Vridhhashram Bikaner, Pali, Nokha, Hindaun, Bassi (Jaipur), Jaipur, Jamdoli (Jaipur), Udaipur, Kuchaman City, Pushkar, Bari (Dholpur), Vijaynagar (Ajmer) Neem Ka Thana (Sikar), Alwar Chikani, Kailadevi (Kaurali) **3 in Delhi** (Puthkhurd, Budpur and Punjabkhore), **14 in Uttar Pradesh** (Shamli, Kokilavan (Mathura), Govardhan,

Hathras, Firozabad, Shukratal, Varanasi, Meerut, Lucknow, Vrindavan, Pilkhua, Noida, Kanpur and Soroji), **5 in M.P.** (Shivpuri Male & Female, Dabra, Bhopal, ratalm and vidhisha), **3 in Gujrat** (Umta (Mehasana), Vadodara, Gandhidham and Viramgam) **3 in Maharashtra** (Pune Male & Female, vasai(Mumbai)), 2 in **Chhattisgarh** (Raigarh and Raipur), **one each in West Bangel** (Purulia), **Haryana** (Bhiwani), Faridkot (Punjab), Roorkee (Uttrakhand) and (Cuttack) **Orissa**. Apart from that one Ashram is running in Bhaktpur Kathmandu in Nepal i.e. outside India. In all 61 Ashrams running by the Organization there are 14711 homeless helpless destitute prabhuji (persons) are being served as on 31st March 2025. In addition to helpless human beings Bharatpur Ashram is also providing services for helpless sick wounded cows, animals and birds. **Apart from that a helpline with name Apna Ghar Helpline Bharatpur and Pradhanmantri Jan Aushadhi Kendra Agra are also being operated by the Organization.**

This concept of the organization is unique and played a vital role to attach the community and philanthropy with the services of these most needy persons of the society. With the help of Apna Ghar Sewa Samities and Helpline members, the scale and coverage of services have been expanded in other part of the country and in Nepal.

Large number of peoples are coming at Apna Ghar Ashrams from all over the country to perusal the services provided to these Prabhuji (Inmates) by the Organization and they feel serenity and satisfaction after visiting here. Our best wishes to all the visitors for strengthening the humanitarian value by helping such hopeless helpless human and other living beings.

Our Ideology

- Service to the hopeless homeless helpless sick people is our prayer and worship.
- No hopeless homeless helpless sick person should be forced to die anywhere in agony due to lack of services and resources.
- Every abandoned helpless and sick person who is without any help and care should have the confidence that he is not alone in that critical situation, he has someone dear to take care of him, he has his Apna Ghar.
- The one who is most needy has the first right on the resources of the organization.
- Every needy person is compulsorily admitted in the Ashram in every situation.
- A letter “ThakurJi ki Chitthi” is written directly to the supreme power “Thakurji” to serve the needy “Prabhuji”, which Thakurji grants by coming in various human forms.
- If the service is genuine then the resources automatically find the service.
- If there is a shortage of any kind of resources, it is an indication that our eligibility is lacking.
- Service is not a favour to anyone, it is our duty.
- If the service is right then the feeling of service gets awakened in the person served, the one who is doing the service gets peace, the person watching the service gets a feeling of compassion and the one who is providing resources have a feeling to provide more resources.

MAJOR INITIATIONS OF THIS YEAR:

For the betterment of the services, the organization takes some core decisions with expansion of services, in which the rescue of prabhuji, increasing the quality of services, optimum utilisation of resources and strengthening the monitoring system of services. These initiatives are as follows:-

a) Sewa Updation Team:

The parameters of the standard of services set by the organization may be fulfilled, for this the monitoring is being done by the coordinators of the organization. If there is any lack of the standards set by the organization found in any Ashram, a Sewa Updation Team has been formed by the organization to recoup the services to the prabhuji as per service standards. In this team there are 5 members related to medical, service, cleaning & care, office and multi-purpose worker. One vehicle has also been allotted to this team to visit the Ashrams as per priority set by the headquarter. After reaching the Ashram, this team inspect the area related to their expertise and prepare a report and thereafter rectify the shortcomings with the staff of the Ashram and also provide training and guidance to them so that the level of services can be maintain as per standards and parameters set by the organization.

b) Mission Destitute Free Rajasthan-II:

To provide the services to every hopeless helpless destitute needy one, the Organization taken an initiative in the State of Rajasthan to free it from such needy ones last year on 29 February 2024. In continuation of this initiative, the second 'Rajasthan state Rescue Mission' was started on 13th October 2024 and completed on 19 October 2025. This mission was again operated with the collaboration of social welfare department and police department of the Rajasthan State. A total of 514 hopeless helpless destitute prabhuji rescued from all over the state. This was a big initiative in which almost every part of the state was covered. The role of the local citizens, media and service providers play a vital role in this operation.

c) Committees of Prabhuji:

By forming the committee of the prabhuji, an innovative initiative was taken by the organization last year. The committees of prabhuji played an excellent role during this year not only monitoring the services but also taking the feedback of the other beneficiary either they are satisfied with the services and what further action should be taken by the organization to improve the services more. The committees submitted their reports in a prescribed format set by the organization by filling all parts with their suggestions.

d) SOPs for the services:

Earlier the organization has only a prescribed service manual and the duties of the sewasathis for the services, now the SOPs (standard operating procedure) for every section has been developed. By these SOPs the dropout at the level of

staff has minimized, services are providing on timely basis and also the staff feels comfort in their duties. By these SOPs and check-lists the monitoring system has become very easy.

e) Sewa Promotion Team:-

The Sewa Promotion Team has been launched in this year in place of coordinators to effectively monitoring the services to the prabhuji in the Ashrams. This team have 3 members who are directly involved in the services of the prabhuji in general. This three member team visits 4 to 5 Ashrams at a time. The team have an Ashram vehicle for their visit and they have to provide enough time to perusal the services and submit their report in a fixed format. The results o this sewa promotion team has been found very effective not only in the monitoring of services but also implementing the guidelines of the headquarters issued time to time to maintain the standard of the services in the Ashram.

EXPENSION OF APNA GHAR ASHRAMS :-

This is an approach, particularly in mobilizing the network and alliance for helping helpless, homeless and sick persons having no resources. Surprisingly these groups are found everywhere but options for serving them are very limited. In crisis of resources, many helpless persons lost their lives due to lack of resources, help and care. It was not feasible to provide services to every inmate from Bharatpur 'Apna Ghar' Ashram. Therefore, to ensure services to every helpless, severe ill person, as per vision of the organization, the Expansion of the services was started by the Organization during 2011-12. During this year 3 new 'Apna Ghar' Ashrams have been started the details of which are as follows-

1.) Apna Ghar Ashram Chikani, Alwar (Raj):-

ARJ Apna Ghar Ashram Chikani, Alwar was inaugurated on **10th May 2024** with **50 beds** capacity. The building for this Ashram was provided by Sh Arjun Kumar Takhtani Ji, Industrialist of Alwar. All **required facilities** such as treatment, food, clothing, residence and other necessities are being provided to the Prabhuji (Residents) without any charges.



1.) Apna Ghar Ashram, Viramgam (Gujarat)

Apna Ghar Ashram **Viramgam** was inaugurated on **21st September 2024** with **100 beds** capacity. The building required for this Ashram was provided by M.P. Birla Group. All **required facilities** such as treatment, food, clothing, residence and other necessities are being provided to the Prabhuji (Resident) without any charges.



2.) Apna Ghar Ashram Kailadevi, Karauli (Raj.):-

Apna Ghar Ashram **Karauli Kaila Devi** was inaugurated on **27th January 2025** near **Kaila Devi Temple, Karauli Rajasthan**. The **50 beds** capacity building has been provided by Dr. Vijay Kishor Bansal & family, Agra. All **required facilities** such as treatment, food, clothing, residence and other necessities are being provided to the Prabhuj (Resident) without any charges. Prabhuj with critical illness are being transferred to Bharatpur ashram for better treatment.

EXPANSION OF ACCOMODATION FACILITIES AND INFRASTRUCTURE During 2024-25:-

With the passage of time, the number of Prabhuji (inmates) are increasing day by day in 'Apna Ghar' Ashrams. So, it becomes necessary to expend the infrastructure and accommodation facilities in the Ashrams and by expanding 'Apna Ghar' Ashrams in other part of the Rajasthan state and the country so that shelter for these homeless helpless hopeless and support less human and other beings can be made available. Most of them are mentally retarded or suffering from mentally sick, old aged, fractured, wounded, T.B, HIV, paralysis and other infectious diseases. In addition, the accidental wounded sick cows, birds and animals are also being served at Apna Ghar Ashram Bharatpur. While expanding the accommodation and other facilities, the need of each inmate is also taken into consideration. The total residential capacity of all the Ashrams as on 31st March 2024 was 10500 beds. During this year the expansion for accommodation facilities and infrastructures developed are as follows:-

1.) Apna Ghar Prabhu Prakalp Bharatpur:

Under Apna Ghar Prabhu Prakalp the construction of 8000 bed capacity home for the homeless helpless destitute females was started on 1st of October 2020. This project was started on 01st October 2020 and its proposed completion date is 30th September 2027. The Phase-I of this project having residential

capacity of 1700 beds was completed and inaugurated on 01st January 2023. During this year the construction of second phase of this project was in progress in which following construction works was completed:-

- a) **Shashi Bhawan:-** This building is constructed on an area 1.34 lakh sqft and having residential capacity is of 1251 bed and inaugurated on 23rd February 2025. This building has been constructed with the support of Sh Nand Kishore ji Todi, Smt Shashi Ji Todi and their Todi Foundation USA.



- b) **Kakar Maaji- Babuji Ka Ghar:-**

This Maaji-Babuji Ka Ghar has been constructed for the old aged pairs (Maaji & Babuji) who have either discarded by their family or have no family in their last phase of life. The capacity of this home is 44 beds (22 Rooms) i.e. residential facility for 22 pairs and the construction was sponsored by Ramsarandas Kishorilal Charitable Trust Delhi/Amritsar through its trustee Sh B.M. Kakar Ji. The inauguration of this building was done on 10th of November 2024.



c) Param Sewa Grah:

This Param Sewa Grah was constructed for those male prabhuji who are in critical condition and required more attention regarding care and other services. The capacity of this home is 200 beds. This home was constructed with the support of Sh Santosh Kumar & Smt Janki Devi Arora, Sh Suresh Chand Memorial Trust and other donors. The inauguration of this building was done on 10th of November 2024.



Expansion of other Existing Apna Ghar Ashrams:

1.) Apna Ghar Ashram Neem Ka Thana (Rajasthan):

During this year the Ashram has extended its capacity by 120 bed by constructing a residential block on the first floor. Now the capacity of this Ashram has been increased up to 200 bed.

2.) Apna Ghar Ashram Shri Ganganagar (Rajasthan):

During this year the capacity of the Ashram has been increased by 50 bed and now the total residential capacity of this Ashram is 201 bed.

3.) Apna Ghar Ashram Kuchaman City (Rajasthan):

40 bed capacity residential building has been constructed during this year and now the capacity of the Ashram has been extended up to 80 bed.

4.) Apna Ghar Ashram Udaipur (Rajasthan):

During this year the Ashram has been shifted to the new building provided by Lions Club Udaipur having residential capacity of 50 beds.

5.) Apna Ghar Ashram Jamdoli (Rajasthan):

The construction of the 200 bed building which was started during 2022-23 was completed during this year.

WORK IN PROGRESS:

Ashram run by the Organization:

1.) Apna Ghar Ashram Bharatpur (Rajasthan):

a) Prabhuji Ashiyana:

The construction of 24 2-BHK flat and 18 1-BHK flats were under construction during the end of this year. The total residential capacity of these prabhuji flats are 132 beds.

b) Administrative Block:

The construction of two floor Administrative block on 9000 sqft area was in finishing stage during this year.

2.) Umta, Mehasana (Gujrat)

Construction of 200 bed capacity building which was started during last year is under progress. There is a provision for both male and female residential homes have been taken in this building.

3.) Govardhan Project:

The boundary wall of the Govardhan project has been completed in this year. For construction of 1000 bedding capacity Ashram, the sanctions of drawings etc. is under process.

4.) Shriganganagar (Rajasthan):

The construction of Administrative block and 2 halls were under progress during this year.

5.) Kota (Rajasthan):

The construction of Old Age Home having residential capacity of 50 bed was under progress during this year.

6.) Vridhashram Jamdoli, Jaipur (Rajasthan):

The construction of the 200 bed building which was started during 2022-23 is under progress and in finishing stage during the end of this year.

Affiliated Ashrams:

7.) Govardhan (U.P.):

The construction of 100 bed building was in finishing stage during this year.

8.) varanasi (U.P.):

The construction of 50 bed building was under progress during this year.

9.) Shivpuri (M.P.):

The construction of 150 bed building on first floor was under progress during this year.

10.) Dabra (M.P.):

The construction of 100 bed building on first floor was under progress during this year.

11.) Jodhpur (Rajasthan):

The construction of 1000 bedding Ashram is in finishing stage and schedule to be inaugurated during 2025-26.

12.) Vridhashram Bikaner (Rajasthan):

The construction of 250 bed residential building is under progress during this year.

13.) Shukratal (U.P.):

The construction of 60 bed residential building is under progress during this year.

Detail of Prabhuji Rescued/ Admitted, Rehabilitated and Expired during 2024-25:-

As on 31 March 2024 there were 13480 Prabhuji (Inmates) residing in all Apna Ghar Ashrams. During this year **8467** Prabhuji (inmates) rescued and admitted and **5352** Prabhuji (Inmates) rehabilitated by all Ashrams. Due to poor health, incurable diseases and old age 1884 persons were expired. The number of prabhuji (Inmates) in all 61 Apna Ghar Ashrams, as on 31st March 2025 were **14711**

Use of modern and latest Technology for improving the quality of services and system:

Our monitoring system at various level makes our services effective which includes-

1. Annual Service Calendar- In this calendar, all activities related to services of the prabhujis, related to meetings of General Body/ Executive of Organization, Ashrams, Samities and helplines, Staff and office bearers trainings and workshops, other office related activities have been classified date wise. Every day as per work/ activities mentioned in the calendar informed to the concern and monitored its compliance through WhatsApp groups. There are 450 activities has been mentioned in the calendar for 365 days of the year.

2. Daily Service Report- of Prabhuji regarding number of prabhujis who have not had food, medicine with reasons, how many prabhuji have not taken their bath, not get their nails cut, how many bedsheets not changed on beds with prescribed reasons, report on toilets and ward inspection, chlorination of water

during the day have to be submit by the ward incharge in office everyday by 2 PM. Other monitoring reports related to Wards, Office, Store, Kitchen, Medical and General Section etc. get from the related sections with checklists, so that quality of the services may be ensured.

3. Accounts, Prabhuji's Data- Admission form with details of prabhuji i.e. Name, age, health status, location from where they have been admitted, name of the informer, driver name and vehicle used for rescue with no., the cash or valuable material found from the prabhuji maintained, data related to their ward, progress of their health, address informed by the prabhuji etc. are also maintained online, by this the report of prabhuji state wise, district wise, disease wise, age wise, gender wise can be downloaded), Store, Staff, Medical and other records are being maintained on the Software developed by the Organization for the same. Face recognition system of the prabhuji has also been developed in the software. By this, the prabhuji can easily be traceable and individual services can be provided to the easily.

4. E-Clinic – Super specialist medical services are getting through E- Clinic from doctors anywhere in the world. Treatment of prabhujis through E-clinic by Doctors from U.S.A, England, in India doctors from Bangalore and Amritsar right now. Presently consulting by doctors through E- Clinic for 16 days in a month are being given for more than 400 prabhujis of Ashram free of charges.

5. Training and workshop for staff and office bearers- The Organization has its own need based service and duty manual. Training and workshop provide to all type of staff to develop the skill and to update the office bearers by the theme/ services of the Organization.

6. Daily planning and timely meetings- To take immediate and proper decisions and planning on day basis, meetings of core committee (constituted with main office bearers), Executive board takes place on regular basis.

7. Care every individual prabhujis- The system is so developed, so that care of every individual prabhuji can be ensured.

9. Transparency and faith- Maximum service part of each section (Medical, Accounts, Literature, Jeev Sewa, Social Media, Establishment, Store, Record Keeping, Prabhuji individual file record, Kitchen etc) is being either executed or monitored through the volunteers of the Organization. Hence all works in the Ashrams are being executed by the volunteers and staff with faith and transparent manner. Any person can get involve in the services of the Ashrams as per his/her interest and ability.

10. Strictly implementation of polices of the Organization at every level.

MEDICAL FACILITY:-

To fulfil the medical requirements of patients of Apna Ghar Ashrams more than 80 part time Doctors, 102 trained nursing staff and health worker engaged in the services during the year. The patient also provide medical treatment in Government Hospital, Medical College and private hospitals as per requirements. In all ashrams there are 94 Ambulances and 2 Animal Ambulances, engaged in the services of helpless severe ill persons to providing immediate medical services and support.

MEDICAL HELPLINE AND MOBILITY:-

Often seen that orphan and helpless patients injured in road accidents are die due to lack of medical support and care. Since the accident occurs in unpredictably manner, no attendants are available to look after these patients/injured persons in hospital, immediately. To fulfil this gap and support interruption, medical helpline support was initiated by the Organization at Bharatpur and Kota. It provides attendants in hospitals until someone from inmates families are not reported or take this responsibility. Apart from this, the staff of the helpline provide support to the old aged persons and villagers to get treatment and medicines easily in the hospital as such newcomers are facing difficulties to get proper information and knowledge about the treatment in the hospital. Every month the organization benefiting more than 250 such type of patients through this helpline.

Apart from the expansion of the services, the Organization is focusing on monitoring and maintaining the quality of services being providing by the Organisation. The details of which are as under-

Expansion of Samities And Helplines:

Organization has limited man power and resources to serve large number of helpless, homeless and resource fewer sick persons. Within these limited resources reaching to every patient is almost impossible for organization alone. For reaching at large number of such person, organization has promoted Apna Ghar Sewa samities (local units) and helpline at District and Tehsil level. 38 Apna Ghar Sewa samities and 58 help lines support the mission and objectives of organization in different part of state and the country at present.

Turning Towards Humanitarian Pilgrim:

The genesis of concept to serve helpless, orphan was inspired spirits and for fulfilling it very limited activities were initiated. This pretty small initiation of

service through Apna Ghar magnificently is turning towards humanitarian hubs. Many of individuals after visiting Apna Ghar and staying couple of days here, inspires with its way of serving and humanity. Large number of people from villages and cities coming to visit Apna Ghar as pilgrimage.

Nation Wide Volunteerism:

In modern age where high majority of population is fascinating to materialistic attributes the increasing numbers of volunteerism for caring humanity and helpless is consisting a big turning of re-synthesis of humanism. And making this in reality Apna Ghar through action based strategy is fortunate enough as numbers of supporters and volunteers have joined. More than 1000000 persons have visited and involved themselves in serving the inmates as per their skills and talents directly or indirectly.

Uniqueness of the Organization:

1. The Organization is working for the last needy person i.e., homeless helpless orphans going towards lingering death.
2. Every such person admit in the Ashram whether the accommodation is available or not. Because the needy outside the Ashram has the first right on the resources of the Ashrams.
3. The services are being executed with direct involvement of the society. So many volunteers are getting involved in the services for these helpless destitute prabhuji in the Ashrams.
4. The services provided in the Ashrams are as per the need of the inmates living in the Ashram not as per the resources available.
5. No donation is collected from the society directly but a letter to God is placed at the board at every Ashram of the Organization and the demand written on the display board always fulfilled by God through various human beings comes at the Ashram.
6. The Organization has its own system to pick up the helpless orphan destitute person from the spot. Ambulances and rescue team at the Ashrams always ready to attend every call received through any means.
7. To reach every such needy, Samities and Helplines constituted by the Organization at local level are also available in many cities, so that service to that needy can be provided without any delay. These Samities and Helplines are working as referral centres for the needy persons found in their areas.

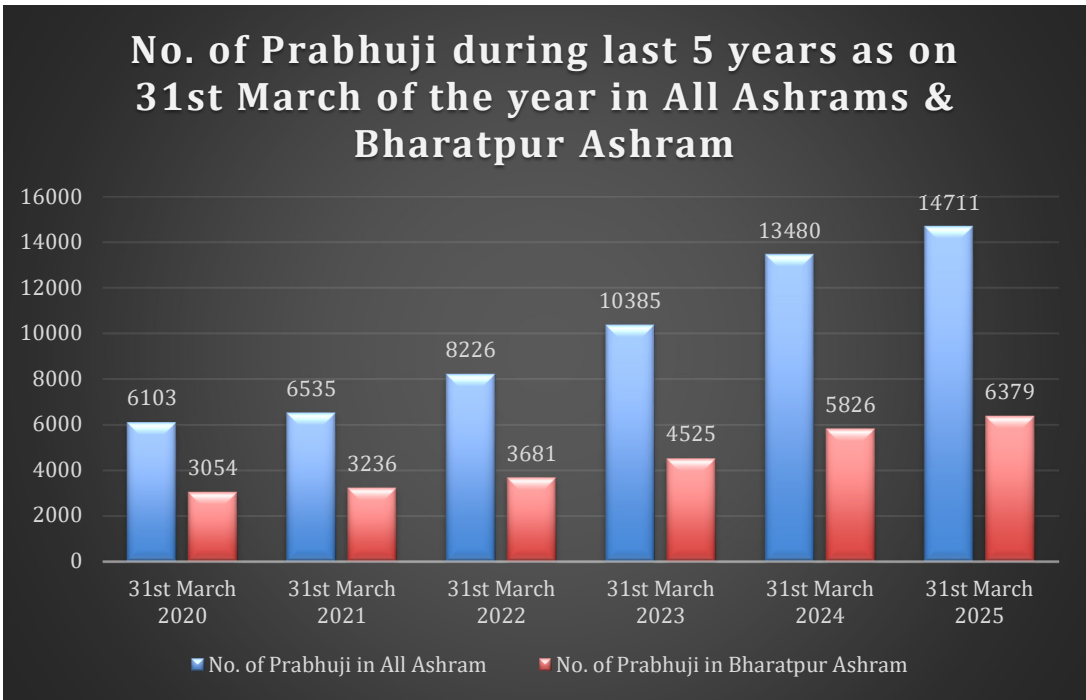
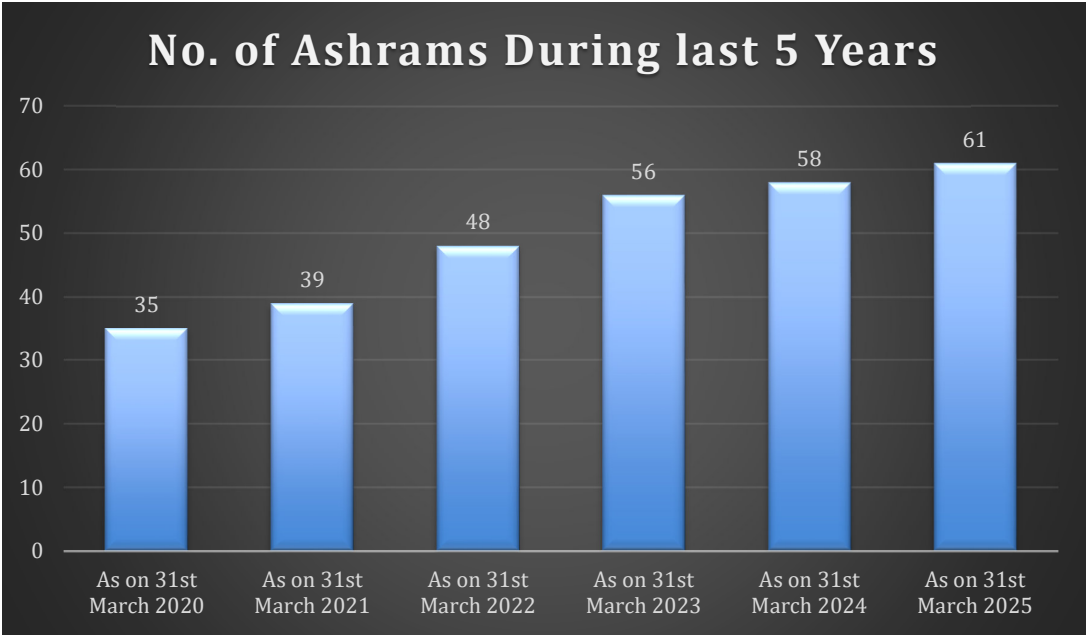
Organizational Achievements:

1. The main achievement of the Organization is that we are following our vision and mission with our ethics and determination.
2. There are 61 Ashrams having residential capacity for more than 15500 beds are being running and we are in a position to cover up almost major part of Northern India to provide services to these homeless helpless hopeless persons.
3. Apna Ghar Ashram Bharatpur is now become the largest institute of India of its kind, as per number of prabhujis, specifications and services.
4. We have rehabilitated more than 35000 such type of prabhujis in their families or other way after been cured, in 23 states of India. During admission prabhujis generally are not in a condition to inform about their addresses, even about their name and number of cases, the name has been given by the Organization. As per regular treatment and care maximum prabhujis are in the position to inform some details about their families. The family addresses informed by the prabhujis are then search by the Rehabilitation Cell of the Organization through internet, police and other means. After searching and confirmation about the family, the information of their family member residing in the Ashram is given and through proper verification and legal formalities the prabhujis handed over to their family. In many cases the family not agree try to take them back, such prabhujis get involved in different service activities like kitchen, sewing, office, medical, construction, gate keeper, Assistance in different sections etc. Some prabhujis are never able to inform about themselves, will be remained in the Ashram and get involved in the services.

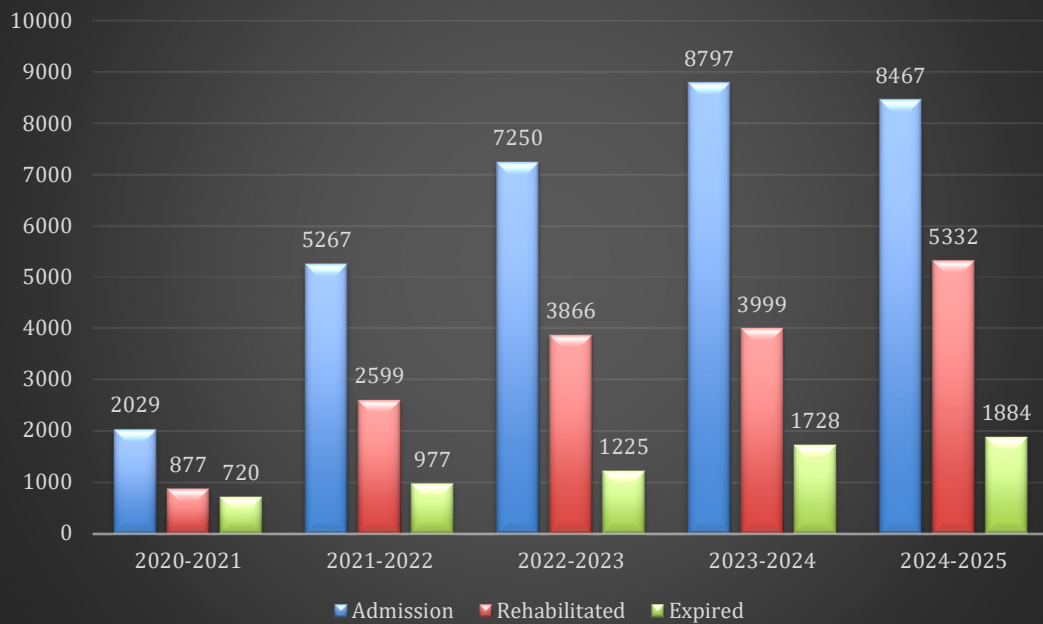
It is our fundamental duty to provide health, moral values, education to the children of the Organization with their family as per possibility. So, the children are admitted in the best schools, so that they can get qualitative education and get employment easily when they become adult. The girls who are in marriage age, the Organization arranges marriage of those girls in well settled families.

5. More than 10 lakh peoples (members, volunteers, donors, helpmates, silent supporters, followers on social media etc.) are attached with the services of the Organization directly or indirectly.
6. The Organization is continually maintaining the quality of services (as mentioned above) with the expansion of Ashrams and continually increasing the number of Prabhujis.
7. Through these services we have developed the faith of the people up to that level that lakhs of people come every year in the Ashrams acknowledging it as a worship place according to their own faith through so many buses and other vehicles with banner of "Pilgrimage of Apna Ghar".

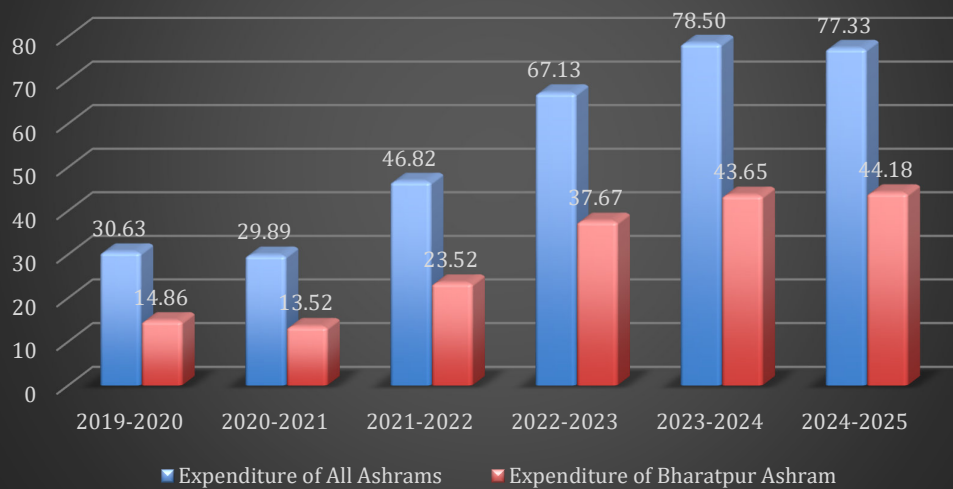
Details of progress the Organization during last 5 years:



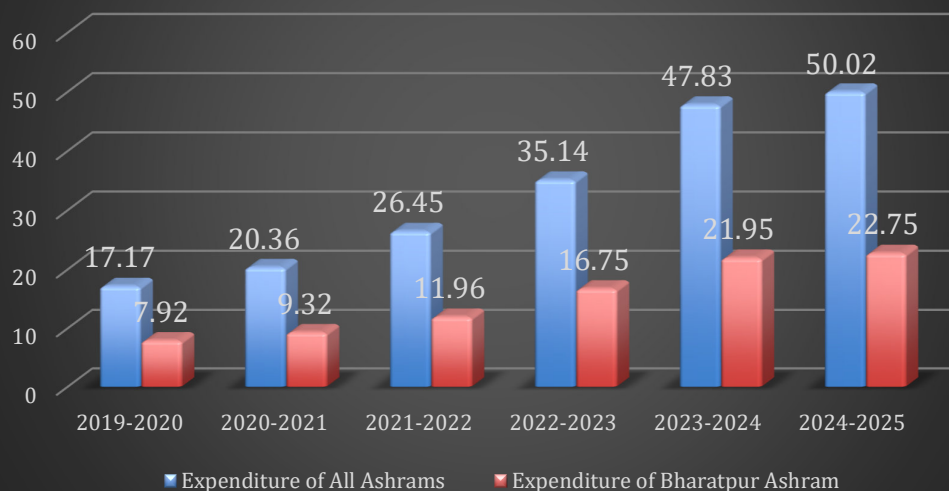
Admission/Rehabilitated/Expired Prabhuji during last 5 Years



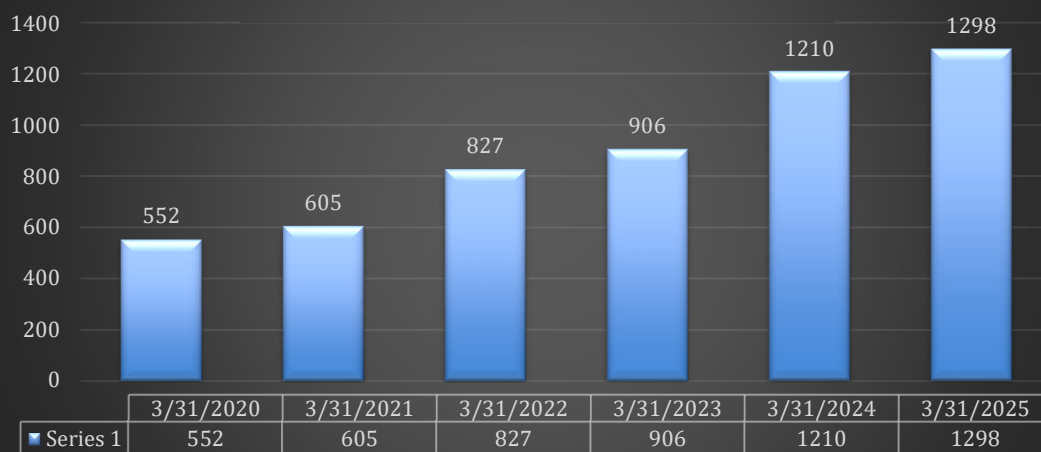
EXPENDITURE OF THE ORGANIZATION AND OF BAHRAPUR ASHRAM DURING LAST 5 YEARS (IN CRORE)
