ANNUAL REPORT-2020-2021

FORWARD: -

The Organization 'Ma Madhuri Brij Varis Sewa Sadan 'Apna Ghar'' is dedicated for achieving the mission 'to serve the living statue of god', who are homeless helpless, mentally and physically sick human beings and accidental or sick, cows and other living beings (birds and animals), generally found on roadside, railway station, bus stands, religious and other public places in very harsh and painful conditions. The Organization is putting all efforts to save the life of these human and other living beings with the blessing of almighty god. They generally found in very unhygienic conditions, suffered with critical diseases, wounded, painful conditions and going towards lingering death due to lack of amenities like food, medicine and shelter. In their critical phase of life, the organization is trying its best to rescue them, provide them treatment, food, shelter and other necessities of life without any charges and with the public support. These are precious human and other living beings and so should not be lost their lives due to lack of the basic need of life. The Organization make all efforts to save the life of these human and other living beings and give them an opportunity to live their life with respect and dignity.

Apna Ghar Ashrams has played a significant role by evolving a new humanitarian concept through alliance and people-based mechanism in order to eradicate the sufferings of homeless helpless and hopeless sick living beings. At the end of this year 48 Apna Ghar Ashrams were running in 10 states of India by the Organization out of which **20 in Rajasthan** (Bharatpur, Ajmer, Kota, Alwar, Bikaner, Jodhpur, Shri Ganganagar, Pali, Nokha, Hindaun, Bassi (Jaipur), Jaipur, Jamdoli (Jaipur), Udaipur, Kuchaman City, Pushkar and Bari (Dholpur)), **2 in Delhi** (Puthkhurd and Budpur), **12 in Uttar Pradesh** (Shamli, Kokilavan (Mathura), Govardhan,

Hathras, Firozabad, Shukratal, Varanasi, Meerut, Aminagar Sarai (Bagpat), Lucknow, Vrindavan, Pilkhua), **4 in M.P.** (Shivpuri, Dabra, Bhopal and Sirsaud), **2 in West Bangal** (Purulia and Kolkata), **3 in Gujrat** (Umta (Mehasana), Vadodara and Gandhidham), **one each in Haryana** (Bhiwani), **Chhattisgarh** (Raigarh), **Orrisa** and **Maharashtra**. Apart from that one Ashram is running in Bhaktpur Kathmandu in Nepal i.e. outside India. In all 48 Ashrams running by the Organization there are 8226 homeless helpless destitute persons are being served as on 31st March 2022. In addition to helpless human beings Bharatpur Ashram is also providing services for helpless sick wounded cows, animals and birds.

This concept of the organization is unique and played a vital role to attach the community and philanthropy with the services of these most needy persons of the society. With the help of Apna Ghar Sewa Samities and Helpline members the scale and coverage of services have been expanded in other part of the country and in Nepal.

Large number of peoples are coming at Apna Ghar Ashrams from all over the country to perusal the services provided to these inmates (Prabhujis) by the Organization and they feel serenity and satisfaction after visiting here. We wish all the visitors to strengthen the humanitarian value by helping such hopeless helpless human and other living beings.

EXPANSION OF INFRASTRUCTURE AND ACCOMODATION FACILITIES During 2021-22:-

With the passage of time, the number of Prabhujis (inmates) are increasing day by day in 'Apna Ghar' Ashrams running by the organization. So, it becomes necessary to expend the infrastructure and accommodation facilities by expanding 'Apna Ghar' Ashrams in other part of the state and the country so that shelter for these homeless helpless hopeless and support less human and other beings can be made available. Most of them are mentally retarded, mentally sick, old aged, fractured, and wounded, T.B, HIV, paralysis and other infectious diseases. In addition, the accidental wounded sick cows, birds and animals are also being served at Apna Ghar Ashram Bharatpur. While expanding the accommodation and facilities, the need of each inmate is also taken into consideration. The expansion of infrastructures and accommodation facilities developed during this year 2021-22 are as follows-

APNA GHAR BANSHI PRAKLAP BHARATPUR:

Looking for the accommodation necessity, the construction of new 'Apna Ghar' Ashram having accommodation capacity for 2000 inmates had been started on dated 4th of November 2011 at a distance of 2 km from the present building of 'Apna Ghar' Ashram. This project is known as 'Bansi Praklap'. The project has been completed during this year and fully utilized for the services of Prabhujis (Inmates). Following buildings/part of the project was completed up to the financial year 2020-21.

1. Matra Sadan-I (A Residential Home for Female) having capacity 720 beds.
2. Matra Sadan-II (A Residential Home for Female) having capacity 800 beds.
3. HIV Block- Having residential capacity for 70 HIV Patients.

4. T.B. Block- Having residential capacity for 70 TB Patients.
5. Puspanjali Param Sewa Grah having capacity of 70 severe ill and wounded persons
6. Shishu evm Baal Grah (Childrens Home) having capacity 100 children
7. Jeev Sewa Sadan having residential capacity for 150 Cows, birds and other animals.
8. Ma Annpurna Prasadalay (Kitchen) having capacity of preparation of food for 2000 persons
9. Guest House- For 35 Guests/ Volunteers
10. Office & Store Building
11. Jeev Sewa Sadan having residential capacity for 150 Cows, birds and other animals.
12. Staff Quarters for 20 employees & Garage
13. Water and Electric facilities
14. Boundary wall and internal roads in campus
15. Apna Ghar Lilavai Hospital
16. Sh Shankar Somani Prasadalay

During this year the following parts has been constructed under this project:-

Construction of 300 beds Prabhu Sadan:

The construction of 300 capacity Prabhu Sadan was started during the last financial year which has been completed during this year and dedicated to the service of Prabhuji. This building has been constructed on 35000 sqft area.





Construction of Apna Ghar Upper Primary School :-

The Apna Ghar Upper Primary School has been completed during this year and the inauguration of the building was held on 17th April 2022. The total covered area of this school is 21208 sqft (Ground +First floor) and it has 10 classrooms, 1 Admn, 1 staff room, 1 restroom, 2 dining, 1 library, 1 computer lab, 1 science lab, 3 store and a big Activity Hall.





APNA GHAR PRABHU PRAKLAP BHARATPUR:

As per the ideology of the Organization, every homeless helpless destitute prabhuji is necessarily given admission in the Ashram irrespective of his/her condition. The destitute are never denied due to lack of space or non-availability of resources in the Ashram. Because of this, there are always remains more Prabhuji than capacity in Bharatpur Ashram and hence the expansion of the Ashram by constructing additional 8000 beds capacity homes along with all required necessities and arrangements just 200 meter away from the present Apna Ghar Ashram Bharatpur had been planned and proposed. After construction, Bharatpur Ashram will be the largest residential home for the homeless helpless destitute prabhuji of its category with total residential capacity for 11000 prahuji.

For this project 22.51 acre of land has been purchased by the organization during this year. This project will be constructed on 60 Acre of land. The provision of separate buildings, for 54 categories of prabhuji have been taken in this project.

Construction of the First Phase of this project is under progress. During this year, the progress of this project was going on in full swing and its target of completion is October 2022. The progress of first phase during this year was as under:

- Boundary wall of 2.5 kilometres completed.
- Construction work of 4 Children Homes (0 to 1.5, 1.5 to 4, 4 to 10 & 10 to 18) with bedding capacity of 135 (Ground floor- 85 +First floor- 50) children was in finishing stage at the end of the year.
- Construction work of 2 Mother's Home having residential capacity of 90 beds (45 beds each) and 2 M.R. Female Homes having residential capacity of 90 beds (45 beds each) in Campus-2 have been completed. Remaining 2 Mother's Home and 2 M.R. Female Homes of Campus-2 were under progress.
- Construction work of Following Homes of Campus-3 were in finishing stage at the end of this year-

Ground Floor:

- Cardiac Home having residential capacity of 70 beds,
- Diabetic Home having residential capacity of 70 beds
- 2 Hospice Homes having residential capacity of 32 beds each.
- Pain Home having residential capacity of 80 beds.

First Floor:

- 2 No. Specific Homes having residential Capacity of 75 beds each.
- 2 No. M.R. Homes having residential capacity of 22 beds each.
- Remaining homes of Campus-3 like Respiratory Home having residential capacity of 75 beds, Physically disable Home with residential capacity of 43 beds on ground floor and Volunteer's Home with residential capacity of 37 beds, 2 No Specific Homes having residential capacity of 80 and 75 beds each on first floor were in progress.
- Roof of basement of Centralized Kitchen (Annpurna Prasadalay) has been laid and construction of ground floor of it is under progress.

- Finishing work in Abhishek Bhawan was also under progress.
- Work of Navgrah Vatika is under progress.
- Cafeteria to provide food items as per choice of the prabhuji was also under progress

EXPENSION OF APNA GHAR ASHRAM :-

This is a new approach particularly in mobilizing the network and alliance for helping helpless, homeless and sick persons having no resources. Surprisingly these groups are found everywhere but options for serving

them are very limited. In crisis of resources, many helpless persons lost their lives due to lack of resources, help and care. It was not feasible to provide services to every inmate from Bharatpur 'Apna Ghar' Ashram. Therefore, to ensure services to every helpless, severe ill person, as per vision of the organization, the Expansion of the services was started by the Organization during 2011-12. Under Expansion Plan 39 'Apna Ghar' Ashram were running at the end of last financial year 2020-21, in 9 States of India, out of which 18 were in Rajasthan (Bharatpur, Ajmer, Kota, Alwar, Bikaner, Jodhpur, Shriganganagar, Pali, Nokha, Hindaun, Bassi (Jaipur), Jaipur, Alwar (Female), Jamdoli (Jaipur)), 2 in Delhi (Puthkhurd and Budpur), 8 in U.P. (Shamli, Kokilavan (Mathura), Govardhan, Hathras, Firozabad, Shukratal, Varanasi and Meerut), 3 in M.P. (Shivpuri, Dabra and Bhopal), 2 in W. Bengal (Purulia and Kolkata), one each in Haryana (Bhiwani), Gujrat (Umta (Mehasana)) and Chhattisgarh (Raigarh). Apart from that one Ashram was running in Bhaktpur Kathmandu in Nepal. During this year 9 new 'Apna Ghar' Ashrams have been started the details of which are as follows-

1.) Pushkar (Rajasthan):

The Old Age Home building having bedding capacity of 50 beds was provided by the Rajasthan Government and taken over charge of this Ashram by our Ajmer Ashram team as on 15th July 2021. The official inauguration of this Ashram was done on 23rd October 2021. This Vridhashram (Old Age Home) will be run by the organization with the support of the Rajasthan Government. At present there are 30 Prabhuji residing in this Ashram.

2.) Sirsaud (Madhya Pradesh):

This Ashram was started on 25th July, 2021. The 25 bedded building for this Ashram has been provided by Madhya Pradesh Government. This Ashram is presently running by our Shivpuri Ashram Team. There are 8 old aged Prabhuji residing in this Ashram at present.

3.) Gandhidham (Gujrat):

This Ashram was started on 18th, July 2021. The 40 bedded building for this Ashram was provided by Sh Snehilal ji Goyal near Oslo Cinema. Apart from that all initial arrangements were also made available by Sh Snehilal Ji for this Ashram. At present there are 27 prabhuji residing in this Ashram.

4.) Bari (Rajasthan):

The 30 bedded capacity building for this Ashram was arranged by our Apna Ghar Sewa Samiti Badi. The Ashram was started on 9th August 2021. This is the 20th Ashram of the Organization in Rajasthan State. At present there are 23 prabhuji residing in this Ashram.

5.) Vrindavan (Uttar Pradesh):

This Ashram was started on 18th August 2021. The 150 bedded capacity building (Parvati Sewa Sadan) has been provided by Sh Jaidev Ji Agarwal and his family for this Ashram. The official inauguration of this Ashram was done on 5th September 2021. There are 65 prabhuji residing in this Ashram at present.

6.) Lucknow (Uttar Pradesh):

The 'Mahila Ashram' (Female Home) building with residential capacity of 75 beds was handed over by the Uttar Pradesh Government for this Ashram on 28th August 2021. On this date 109 female Prabhuji were already residing in this building. All arrangements thereafter were made by the Organization to run this Ashram and to provide services and care for the Prabhuji.

7.) Cuttack (Orissa):

Apna Ghar Ashram Cuttack was started on 13th December 2021. The 100 bedded building for this Ashram was constructed by Sh Shukhdev Ji Agrawal and his family in Satbatia, Jagatpur, Cuttack near Mahanadi. This is the first Ashram of the organization in Orissa.

8.) Pilkhua (Uttar Pradesh):

Apna Ghar Ashram Pilkhua was started on 25th December 2021. The 150 bedded building for this Ashram was constructed by Om Namah Dharmarth Trust Pilkhua and dedicated to Prabhu sewa.

9.) Pune (Maharashtra):

Apna Ghar Ashram Pune was started on 5th March 2022 with the efforts of Sh Rajiv Agarwal and his wife Smt Minakshi Agarwal in the rented building having capacity 80 beds. This Ashram is only for female and is the first Ashram of the Organization in Maharashtra.

Proposed New Ashrams:

There are 6 Ashrams proposed to be started near future. The details of which are as under-

Expansion of Existing Apna Ghar Ashrams:

1.) Nokha, Bikaner (Rajasthan):

The construction of a 600 beds residential building for this Ashram is in finishing stage. The inauguration of 200 bedding capacity part of this building was done by sifting the prabhuji from the old building to the new one on dated 05th September 2021. There are 216 prabhuji residing and taken care of in this Ashram at present.

2.) Shri Ganganagar (Rajasthan):

The construction of 500 bedding capacity building for this Ashram is under progress and scheduled to be completed within next 2 years. The 15 bedded hospital building (Janta Clinic) and 80 bedded residential building for prabhuji has already been completed. The construction work on ground floor with residential capacity 200 beds is scheduled to be completed by June 2022. The inauguration of this residential part of this building was done on dated 25th July 2021 by sifting the Prabhuji from old rented building to this new one. There are 95 prabhuji residing and taken care of in this Ashram at present.

3.) Vridhhashram Jamdoli, Jaipur (Rajasthan):

This Ashram initially was started in the Vridhhashram building given by the Government of Rajasthan in Jamdoli, Jaipur for 25 old aged females. Now the Government of Rajasthan extended this permission from 25 to 200 females and accordingly the Administration and Kitchen buildings at Jamdoli were provided for this extension. The renovation works in both the buildings have been completed and at present there are 103 old aged females are residing and being care of in this Ashram.

4.) Shivpuri (M.P.):

The construction of 600 beds capacity building is under progress and first phase of this Ashram having capacity 120 beds has been completed and inaugurated on 5th February 2022 with the admission of prabhuji. There will be two separate blocks in this building and a provision of an hospital has also been taken.

5.) Budpur (Delhi):

Construction work for 200 bedding capacity building is in progress.

5.) Bassi, Jaipur (Rajasthan):

Inauguration of 51 beds capacity building held on 10th October 2021 and the foundation ceremony for the construction of 51 beds building on first floor held on 10th January 2022 in Baasi Ashram.

6.) Alwar Female (Rajasthan):

Construction of 100 bed capacity building on first floor of the Ashram building was in finishing stage at the end of this year.

6.) Shukratal (Uttar Pradesh):

Construction work for 200 bedding capacity building is in progress.

7.) Meerut (Uttar Pradesh):

Construction work for 60 bedding capacity building is in progress.

Detail of Prabhuji Rescued/ Admitted, Rehabilitated and Expired during 2021-22:-

As on 31 March 2021 there were **6535** Prabhuji (Inmates) residing in all Apna Ghar Ashrams. During this year **5267** Prabhuji (inmates) admitted and **2599** Prabhuji (Inmates) rehabilitated by all Ashrams. Due to poor health, incurable diseases and old age 977 persons were expired. The strength of inmates in all Apna Ghar Ashrams running by the Organization, as on 31st March 2022 were **8226**.

Medical Services at Apna Ghar:-

During this period, we have operated 287 patients which includes ortho, eye and general surgery at Apna Ghar Hospital and Private Hospitals as per need. 37 prabhujis rescued in such a severe condition that maggots were found in their different body parts. 52 rescued prabhujis were found HIV+, 45 rescued prabhujis were found T.B. and 26 prabhujis rescued were found Hepatitis. 6 rescued prabhujis were suffering from cancer. There were many rescued prabhujis found very severe anaemia with haemoglobin between 2 to 4 % and for saving the life of 108 such prabhujis immediate blood was transfused.

During this period, there were 15 rescued females found pregnant who were M.R. and mentally sick, they were very weak and malnourished due to not getting proper food and other required nutrition on time. The medical check-up, sonography and other investigation were conducted at Apna Ghar Ashram and accordingly the treatment was given. Out of the above, the delivery of 15 females has been done and all the 15 babies are although healthy but malnourished. All these are kept under the observation of a paediatrician. Mothers of most of these babies are unable to look after their babies.



There are so many doctors providing their volunteer services in Apna Ghar Ashrams to the prabhuji. At Bharatpur Ashram, which is also the headquarter of the organization, there are 20 doctors providing their volunteers services to the prabhuji out of which there are 4 surgeons, 3 physician, 3 psychiatrists, 3 orthopaedic surgeons, 4 anaesthesia, 1 dental surgeon, 1 eye surgeon and 1 paediatrician.

Apart from the expansion of the services, the Organization is focusing on monitoring and maintaining the quality of services being providing by the Organisation. The details of which are as under-



Best Service Mission- 2022: -

Apna Ghar Organization has dedicated the year 2022, for best services to the prabhuji. Under this mission, the Ashrams are providing timely medication, food, home, clothing with best services. The object of the organization is to reach every such prabhuji who is in crises and facing a critical phase in life due to his/her physically or mentally sickness. By this mission, the object is to take our services to the prabhuji at such level where everybody in the society motivate to serve such person who is in need. For this, we have provided specific training and organize workshop to the staff and officials in which they have trained about the object, how it will be implemented? What is our focus? And what will be the results of this mission. By implementing this mission, the prabhuji will be recovered fast, they will feel and live a happy life, they can also be rehabilitated in a short period. Also, the attitude and working mode of the staff will definitely be change. This is the best and ideal way to reach and help every such needy person and to motivate the society towards helpless destitute sick persons.

Sewa Updation Team:

During this year we have initiated a new concept for monitoring, implementation and maintaining the services of all the Ashrams by introducing a team of staff

having experts of office, medical, direct services, cleaning & multi-purpose worker. This team is monitoring, implementing and updating the services of every Ashram as per norms of the Organization and submit its report to the head quarter for further follow-up.

Second Wave of Covid-19:

First wave of COVID 19 was a big challenge in 2020 and handling the second wave in 2021 has also been a daunting task for us. The COVID situation forced us to change our priorities and we embarked on the way to save our prabhuji from this pandemic. These times had been unprecedented and people across the world have had an impact on them. Consequently, our monthly donations dropped by almost 40%.

Before the start of this wave, we had vaccinated all our staff and prabhuji and also procured required corona related medicines, equipment's, facemasks, sanitizers, globs and PPE kits etc. By this, we were successfully able to save our prabhuji (who are the most vulnerable group) during this devastating covid wave of 2021.

Throughout this time period very strict guidelines were implemented and followed to keep the virus away from the Ashrams. During second wave of covid-19, we found 49 Prabhu ji covid positive from the rescued prabhuji and 10 staff members also got affected from corona during this period.

During this phase, the efforts and dedication of our staff have helped us in combating these trying times. We are indebted to all our team members, who remained away from their families and stayed in the Ashrams for 2 months to take extra care of Prabhu Jis. During the second wave we have restricted the entries of all the visitors to the wards as the safety of Prabhuji remain our priority.

Other Services During Second Wave of Covid-19:

Oxygen Concentrators Service:

The Covid second wave was very devastated and was impacting on the human lives very badly. Peoples suffering with Covid 19 were not getting admissions due to large number of patients in the hospitals all over. People were also suffering from low oxygen levels. So, an idea to start some unique service came into our minds and we started providing free Oxygen Concentrators to people who were suffering from Covid 19 and facing the problems due to lack of Oxygen and those, whose oxygen level was less than 90 and doctors advised them for the same. We have provided 107 concentrators in total, out of which around 40+ concentrators are still in use.

Additionally, we provided an ambulance with six oxygen beds along with additional concentrators cover the risk, outside the civil hospital for the help of people who were not getting admissions in the hospital due to large number of patients admitted in their wards.



Distribution of Roshan Kits for the poor needy families affected from Covid-19:

The distribution of Roshan Kits (food kit) has been done for the needy poor families who have lost their jobs and are facing a critical phase of life and not in a position to arrange food items for the family. A total of 1200 Roshan kits having 15 food items and cost approximately 1000 per kit were provided till date to these families and the project is still going on with the help of our supporters from NRIs USA and from India.



Expansion of Ashram, Samities and Helplines: -

Organization has limited man power and resources to serve large number of helpless, homeless and resource fewer sick persons. Within these limited resources reaching to every patient is almost impossible for organization alone. For reaching at large number of such person, organization has promoted Apna Ghar seva samities (local units) and helpline at District and Tehsil level. 41 Apna Ghar seva samities and 58 help lines support the mission and objectives of organization in different part of state and the country at present.

Turning Towards Humanitarian Pilgrim: -

The genesis of concept to serve helpless, orphan was inspired spirits and for fulfilling it very limited activities were initiated. This pretty small initiation of service through Apna Ghar magnificently is turning towards humanitarian hubs. Many of individuals after visiting Apna Ghar and staying couple of days here, inspires with its way of serving and humanity. Large number of people from villages and cities coming to visit Apna Ghar as pilgrimage.

Nation Wide Volunteerism: -

In modern age where high majority of population is fascinating to materialistic attributes the increasing numbers of volunteerism for caring humanity and helpless is consisting a big turning of re-synthesis of humanism. And making this in reality Apna Ghar through action-based strategy is fortunate enough as numbers of supporters and volunteers have joined. More than 300000 persons have visited and involved themselves in serving the inmates as per their skills and talents directly or indirectly.

Uniqueness of the Organization:-

1. The Organization is working for the last needy person i.e., homeless helpless orphans going towards lingering death.
2. Every such person admit in the Ashram whether the accommodation is available or not. Because the needy outside the Ashram has the first right on the resources of the Ashrams.
3. The services are being executed with direct involvement of the society. So many volunteers are getting involved in the services for these helpless destitute prabhujis in the Ashrams.
4. The services provided in the Ashrams are as per the need of the inmates living in the Ashram not as per the resources available.
5. No donation is collected from the society directly but a letter to God is placed at the board at every Ashram of the Organization and the demand written on the display board always fulfilled by God through various human beings comes at the Ashram.
6. The Organization has its own system to pick up the helpless orphan destitute person from the spot. Ambulances and rescue team at the Ashrams always ready to attend every call received through any means.

7. To reach every such needy, Samities and Helplines constituted by the Organization at local level are also available in many cities, so that service to that needy can be provided without any delay. These Samities and Helplines are working as referral centres for the needy persons found in their areas.

8. The admission in Apna Ghar Ashram is given to every disease needy person of all age group as well as accidental sick cows, animals and birds.

9. We run Apna Ghar Ashram in every city of the country where we get proper residential building and start Apna Ghar Sewa Samiti where we get a team of at least 21 members.

Organizational Achievements:

1. The main achievement of the Organization is that we are following our vision and mission with our ethics and determination.

2. There are 48 Ashrams having residential capacity for more than 7500 beds are being running and we are in a position to cover up almost major part of Northern India to provide services to these homeless helpless hopeless persons.

3. Apna Ghar Ashram Bharatpur is now become the largest institute of India of its kind, as per number of prabhujis, specifications and services.

4. We have rehabilitated more than 22000 such type of prabhujis in their families or other way after been cured, in 23 states of India. During admission prabhujis generally are not in a condition to inform about their addresses, even about their name and number of cases, the name has been given by the Organization. As per regular treatment and care maximum prabhujis are in the position to inform some details about their families. The family addresses informed by the prabhujis are then search by the Rehabilitation Cell of the Organization through internet, police and other means. After searching and confirmation about the family, the information of their family member residing in the Ashram is given and through proper verification and legal formalities the prabhujis handed over to their family. In many cases the family not agree try to take them back, such prabhujis get involved in different service activities like kitchen, sewing, office, medical, construction, gate keeper, Assistance in different sections etc. Some prabhujis are never able to inform about themselves, will be remained in the Ashram and get involved in the services.

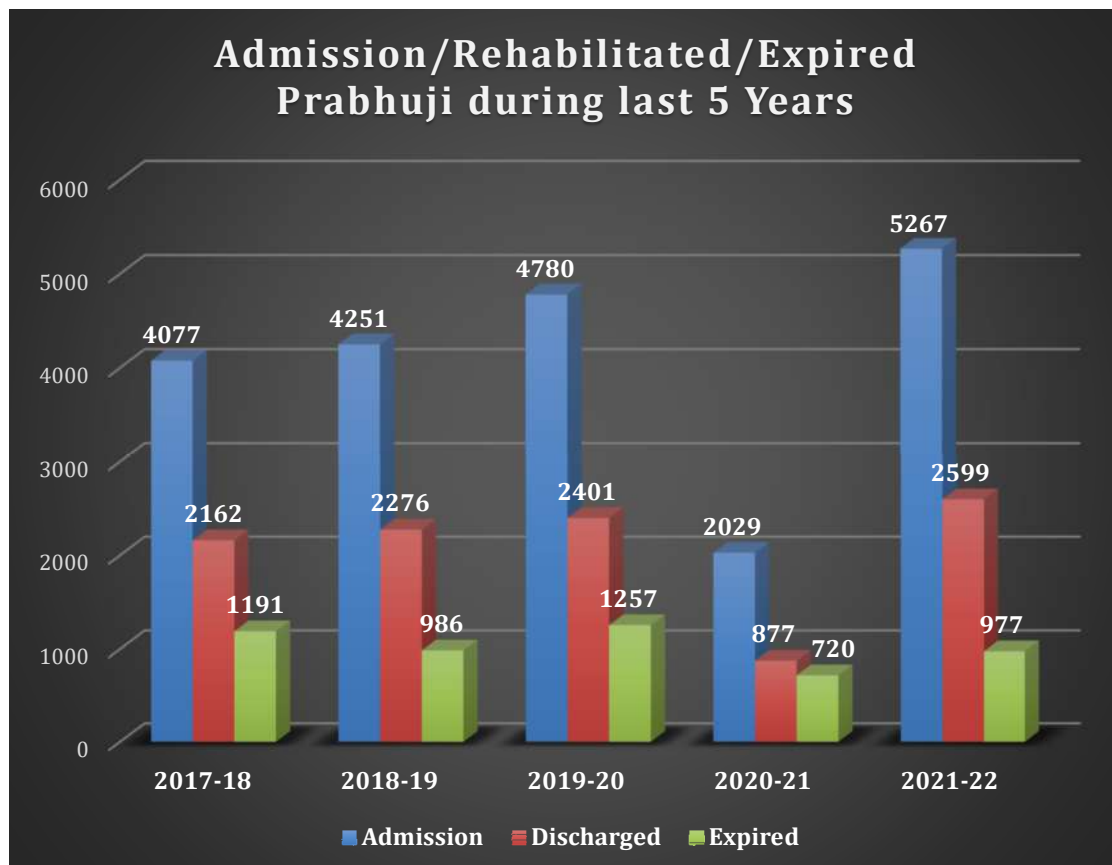

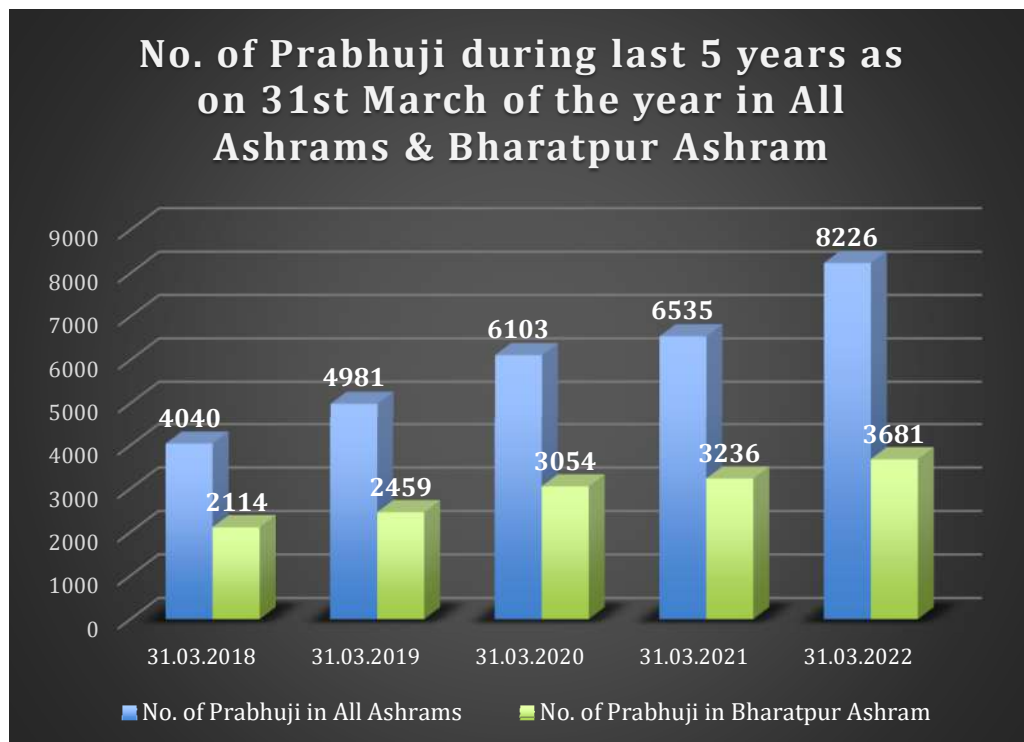
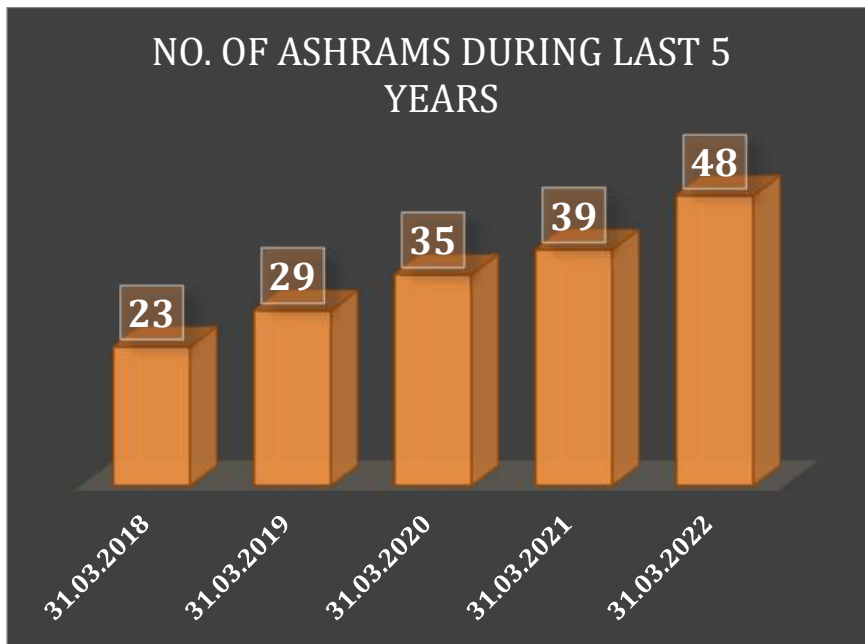

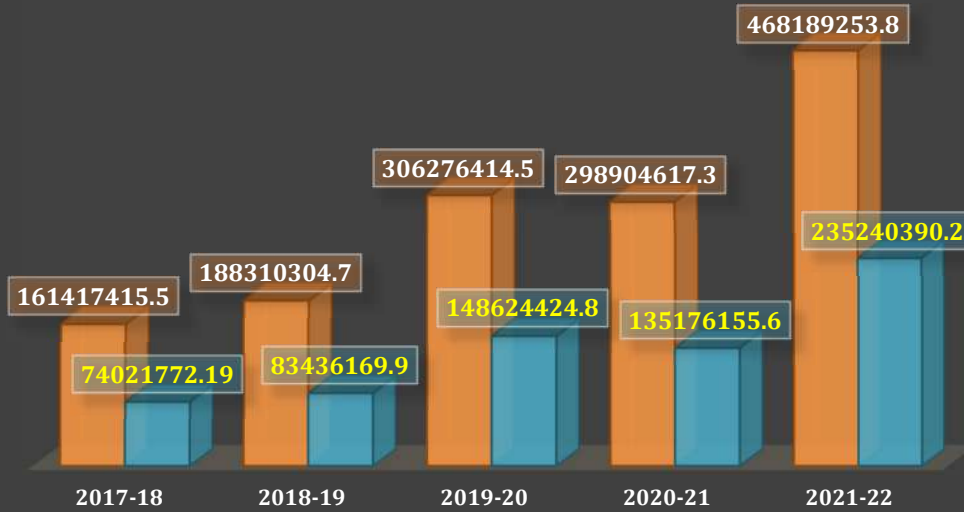
Details of progress the Organization during last 5 years:



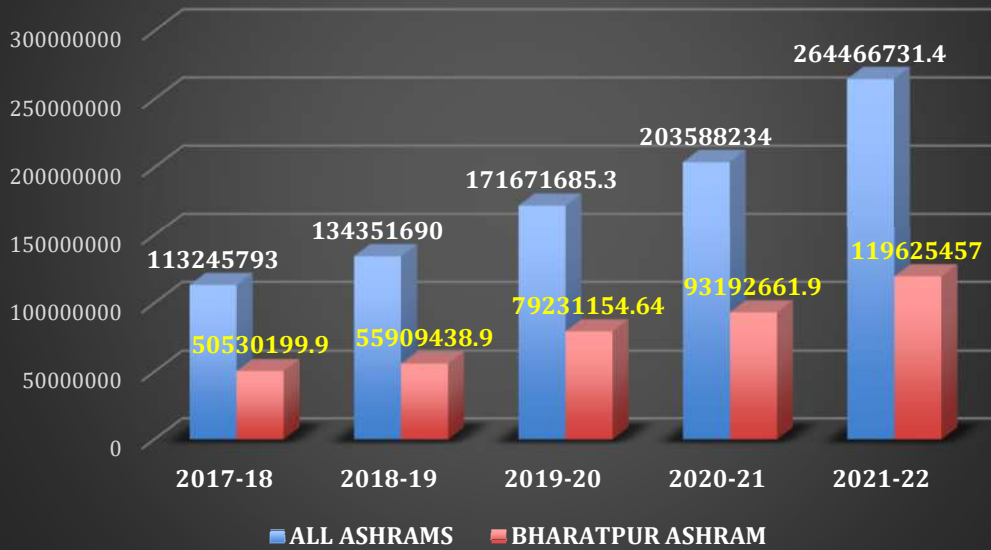


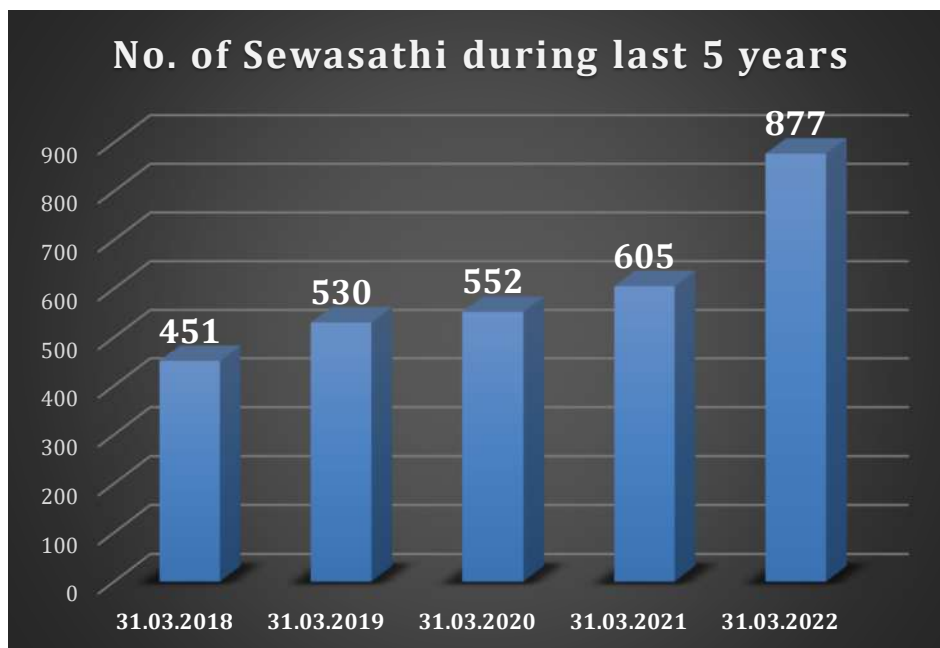
EXPENDITURE OF THE ORGANIZATION AND OF BHRATPUR ASHRAM DURING LAST 5 YEARS
