About The Organization :-

Maa Madhuri Brij Varis Sewa Sadan Apna Ghar Sanstha was established on 29 June 2000 in Bharatpur, Rajasthan, with the mission to care for helpless homeless sick hopeless abandoned and destitute individuals suffering on roads side, public and religious places in extremely painful and neglected conditions.

The organization operates residential care homes called "Apna Ghar Ashram", where residents receive everything free of cost, including:

- Medical and surgical treatment
- Nutritious food and clean clothing
- Safe shelter and personal care
- Emotional support and compassion
- Physiotherapy
- Emotional & psychological support
- Round-the-clock caregiving
- Complete dignity, respect and love

Apna Ghar is especially meant for those who have no one of their own... or for those who have been rejected, abandoned and forgotten by their own families.

People who neither have the resources to live nor a loving hand to offer even a morsel of food...

People whose bodies have become the home of countless illnesses, whose wounds cry silently, whose souls ache in isolation...

People lying helpless, waiting for someone to lift them, hold them, save them.

For such shattered lives who have lost all hope,

Apna Ghar becomes a ray of light — a place where life begins again, where dignity returns, where unconditional love embraces those whom the world has turned away from.

Today, the organization runs 68 Apna Ghar Ashrams across 12 states of India including 25 in Rajasthan, 18 in Uttar Pradesh, 3 in Delhi, 5 in Madhya Pradesh, 5 in Gujarat, 4 in Maharashtra, 2 each in Chhattisgarh & Haryana, and one each in West Bengal, Punjab, Uttarakhand, and Odisha. Additionally, an Apna Ghar Ashram is also operational in Kathmandu, Nepal. Apna Ghar Ashram Bharatpur, largest Ashram in the World of its kind spread over 45 acres, 6,780 residents, including 3,348 females. Nearly 90% require continuous medical care, while 40% need total dependency on caregivers.

Apna Ghar is built on the belief that service to the suffering is the purest form of prayer, and every helpless being is a manifestation of the Divine.

- Service is not charity it is our duty.
- No one should die on the streets due to lack of care and treatment.

- The most needy have the first right to our resources.
- Every person is admitted without any conditions and discrimination.
- Every Ashram writes a daily letter to Thakur Ji (God) for every need medicines, food, clothing, salaries, ambulance, fuel, even small daily requirements and miraculously help arrives.

This faith-driven service is the soul of our organization.

To build a compassionate world where no helpless, destitute, sick, or abandoned person suffers on the streets — where everyone receives dignity, care, and unconditional love and every individual has "Apna Ghar" — a home of their own.

- Establish and expand Apna Ghar Ashrams across India & beyond.

❖ What We Do:-

We rescue and rehabilitate: Homeless Helpless Hopeless Sick, Abandoned, Injured, Mentally ill Elderly and children without support and without discrimination of caste, greed or religion. Many are found in critical condition — starving, injured, infected (often with maggots), mentally disturbed, or terminally ill.
